

RU BCL protests charge sheet against Hasina

Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) yesterday expressed grave concern over the recent filing of a charge sheet against Awami League President Sheikh Hasina and 45 14-party leaders for Paltan violence on October 28 in 2006.

The Rajshahi University leaders also demanded withdrawal of the charge sheet. They said submission of charge sheet is a part of a conspiracy by the BNP-Jamaatfour-party alliance.

They in a statement yesterday said filing of the charge sheet will hamper the democracy.

They demanded immediate withdrawal of the charge sheet and people responsible for the attack should be arrested.

The signatories to the statement include BCL RU unit General Secretary Ayeen Uddin, Joint Secretary Uzzal, Masud, BCL RU unit members Rubel, Samiul, Tuhin and former BCL central committee member Rashidul Islam.

5 establishments fined in Sylhet

A mobile court yesterday realised Tk 95,000 from five establishments, including hotel, restaurants and diagnostic centers, in the city for different reasons.

Class One Magistrate Devjit Sinha conducted the drive while officials of Bangladesh Standard Testing Institute and Sylhet City Corporation were also present during the drive.

The mobile court realised Tk 50,000 from Hotel Supreme because of its unhygienic kitchen.

It also fined Raj Pharmacy Tk 30,000 for storing and selling date-expired medicines while realised Tk 3,000 from Al-Razi Diagnostics on charge of lack of necessary arrangements.

The mobile court also fined two restaurants Tk 3,000 each for unhygienic arrangements.
