### I. Objectives

- to encourage individuals and organisations based in South Asia to undertake programmes and activities complementing and supplementing the efforts of SAARC;
- to honour outstanding contributions and achievements of individuals and organisations of the region in the fields of peace, development, social service, poverty alleviation, environment protection, cultural progress and in other agreed areas of regional cooperation; and
- to recognise any other outstanding achievements, not covered above, of individuals and organisations in the region whose work or contribution has benefited or inspired the region.

### II. The Award

The Award consists of a citation, a gold medal and cash prize of US\$ 25,000 (United States dollars twenty-five thousand).

### III. Terms and conditions

- Nominations must be made on the prescribed Nomination Form available on the SAARC Website [www.saarc-sec.org](http://www.saarc-sec.org) with the link SAARC AWARD 2006 and be supported by the required documents.

## Request for Expressions of Interest (REOI)

The People's Republic of Bangladesh intends to apply for financing in the amount of about US\$24 million equivalent from the International Development Association (IDA) toward the cost of the proposed, Public Procurement Reform Project II (PPRP-II) to be implemented by Central Procurement Technical Unit (CPTU) of Implementation Monitoring and Evaluation Division (IMED) under Ministry of Planning, Government of Bangladesh (GoB), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for the services described below. The broad objective of this long-term consultancy assignment is to provide project implementation and procurement capacity development support to CPTU. The key responsibility of the consultant will be to institutionalise procurement capacity development in Bangladesh in a sustained manner with an articulated program through partnership with an identified local institute, Engineering Staff College Bangladesh (ESCB), which is affiliated with Institution of Engineers of Bangladesh. Major elements of the assignment include:

- providing support to CPTU to help implement the project successfully and attain its development objectives, measured through a set of pre-defined results monitoring indicators. The project is expected to continue for about five years;
- completing the remaining limited tasks concerning documentations for policy reform actions continuing from what has been achieved till date under the current Public Procurement Reform Project (PPRP), due for closing in June 2007;
- implementing, under CPTU's coordination, an extensive procurement capacity building program mainly with ESCB and partly with BIM by instituting a well-articulated program covering an array of training instruments ranging from the main three-week residential courses to one-day awareness workshops. The three-week course is likely to cover largely the compliance-based training on procurement of goods, works, and services, included in it a basic short module on procurement core competence skills of the Chartered Institute of Purchasing & Supply (CIPS, UK). The three-week courses will largely be conducted at ESCB, with part of it in the Bangladesh Institute of Management (BIM). Other short courses will be conducted in different suitable institutes as will be identified and arranged by CPTU; and
- institutionalizing procurement capacity development in Bangladesh with substantial local input by developing a qualified and sustainable procurement faculty in ESCB and creating a group of high-performing procurement professionals in target sectoral agencies.

CPTU now invites eligible consultants to submit their Expressions of Interest (EOI) for providing the services. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.). The EOIs would be reviewed on the basis of the following to prepare a short list:

- Registration of the firm/institute
- Availability of appropriate skills among staff
- Demonstrated capacity to handle such assignment
- Experience in similar task (implementation support, compliance & competence training).

Consultants may associate to enhance their qualification, but should mention whether the association is in the form of a "joint-venture" or of "sub-consultancy". All members of such association should have real and well-defined inputs to the assignment, and it is preferable to limit the total number of firms/institutes in the association to three. For the proposed assignment, ESCB will be the nominated sub-consultant, which, among others, will provide local staff input for developing a procurement faculty of its own and for the three-week residential and other short training courses including course materials with adequate classrooms, accommodation, logistics, etc.

The consultant will be selected in accordance with the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers (May 2004, revised October 2006).
