Recruitment of Short Term Consultants

The Smallholder Agricultural Improvement Project (SAIP) is being executed by the Department of Agricultural Extension (DAE) under the Ministry of Agriculture (MOA). The project is supported by International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD). The project management unit (PMU) is inviting application for the following positions. The positions will be fulfilled by suitable individual consultants. The duties and responsibilities will include but, not limited to the following:

1. Project Management Adviser/Team Leader (01 position for 06 months)

This is a senior management level position and will be held responsible for overall designing, planning and preparation of the Project Completion Report (PCR) for SAIP. The management for all sorts of activities to be required for preparation of project completion report to be shouldered by the position. Good collaborative relations to be maintained to both GOB and donor for satisfactory report preparation. The position would have to plan, assign and manage the activities of the other consultants for report preparation. The nature of work is to act as bridge between GOB and donor as well as extensive field works to be done at the project sites to validate the generated information needs to be incorporated in the final report. The management adviser is to assist other consultants in report preparation. The position is also to assist the related staff to successfully close the project with donor and GOB in respect of financial and other management issues.

Qualifications & requirements:

- Post graduate degree preferably PhD in agricultural sciences/social sciences
- More than 15 years working experience in GOB/donor project; preference will be given to the candidates worked as consultant in the SAIP project earlier
- Experience in management level position in donor assisted projects would be necessary
- Computer skill (word, Excel, power point) and reporting skill (English) would be highly essential
- Experience as team leader of multidisciplinary consultants to be treated as added advantage
- Experience in preparation of project completion report or terminal report of IFAD assisted poverty reduction project would be preferred.

2. Extension & Training Expert (01 position for 02 months)

The position will mainly be responsible for compilation of project activities completed during the implementation phase in respect of a) technology demonstration b) beneficiary training c) skill development/training of staff (all stakeholders) d) extension visits of beneficiary, staff/officers e) other extension activities like technology fair, field days, farmers rallies etc. The position will also be capable of arranging workshops by organizing different stakeholders of the project including group leaders to drag out the impact on the livelihood improvement of beneficiaries. The consultant would have to collect information directly from the beneficiaries regarding project activities following PRA techniques. He/she is to assist other consultants to collect their necessary information from different stakeholders and report preparation. The consultant would have to produce the report on technology transfer section (agricultural development and support for Adibasi & charland) of the project. He/she would have good mental make up to work as a team member under team leader and project coordinating director.

Qualifications & requirements:

- Post graduate degree in agricultural sciences/social sciences
- More than 15 years working experience in GOB/donor project; preference will be given to the candidates worked as agricultural consultant in the SAIP project earlier.
- Experience in extension & training position in donor assisted projects would be necessary
- Computer skill (word, Excel, power point) and reporting skill (English) would be essential
- Experience as member of multidisciplinary consultants team under a firm or direct recruitment would be needed
- The candidate would have experience in preparation of project report of IFAD assisted poverty reduction project

3. Credit Management Expert (01 position for 02 months)

The position will be held responsible for compilation of credit management activities (delivery and recovery of micro credit to the beneficiaries by the partner NGOs) of the project during implementation phase. The consultants will have to identify the best suited income generation activities of the beneficiaries based on their impacts to the livelihood improvement of the target population. The information is to be generated by direct interaction with the beneficiaries through PRA sessions and organizing seminar/workshop with the stakeholders. The partner organizations are to be graded by evaluating their activities during the project phase. The position would have to prepare a consolidated completion report for the rural savings & credit as well as for rural community support section of the project. The consultant will have to assist other experts for collecting related information from the field offices of the stakeholders. He/she would have good mental make up to work as a team member under team leader and project coordinating director.

Qualifications & requirements:

- Post graduate degree preferably in agricultural economics/social sciences
- More than 15 years working experience in GOB/donor project; preference will be given to the candidates worked as credit consultant in the SAIP or other IFAD projects earlier
- Experience in credit management position in donor/IFAD assisted projects would be necessary
- Easy accessibility in Sonali Bank management and NGO sector would be treated as added advantage
- Computer skill (word, Excel, power point) and reporting skill (English) would be essential
- Experience as member of multidisciplinary consultants team under a firm or direct recruitment would be necessary
- The candidate would have experience in preparation of project report of IFAD assisted poverty reduction project.

4. MIS Specialist (01 position for 04 months)

The position would be responsible for evaluating the project impacts to the general livelihood improvement of beneficiaries in respect of different poverty reduction indicators. The expert would have to measure the project impact using quantifiable indicators through direct interaction with the beneficiaries as well as field personnel of different stakeholders. The expert would have to analyze the necessary data to be collected in relation to project completion report (PCR) and draw conclusion of their advantages and disadvantages. He/she would have to attend several workshops and PRA sessions in the field to quantify the project impacts. Based on the nature of the project impact the consultant would have to formulate/estimate the post project sustainability of the project benefits toward the beneficiaries. The consultant will have to assist other experts in analyzing important data/information and in compilation of data towards standard reporting form. He will be responsible for preparing project report on impact and sustainability. He/she would have good mental make up to work as a team member under team leader and project coordinating director.

Qualifications & requirements:

- Post graduate degree preferably in agricultural economics/social sciences
- More than 15 years working experience in GOB/donor project; preference will be given to the candidates worked as M & E/MIS consultant in the SAIP or other IFAD projects earlier
- Experience in MIS position in donor/IFAD assisted projects would be necessary
- High degree computer skill (word, Excel, power point etc.) and reporting skill (English) would be essential
- The candidate would have experience as member of multidisciplinary consultants team under a firm or direct recruitment
- Should have experience in preparation of completion report of IFAD assisted poverty reduction project.
