# Ominous fate in foreign land better than life at home?

## "Deshantori" screened

EARLY 2005: 26 Bangladeshis stranded at the Mediterranean Sea. No food or water for over a week has left 10 of them dead. A few of them have started considering their compatriots as potential "food". Festered corpses had to be dumped in the sea... continents away from loved ones.

The film was recently screened by Development Studies Group (DSG) of Independent University, Bangladesh at Radius Centre, Bay's Galleria.

The fact that a significant percentage of our

rubber boat, the documentary also provides an insight into the psyche of young Bangladeshis and commentaries by Dr. Muhammed Zafar Iqbal and Anisul Haque, among others.

A student points out, "In most cases, the references we study have nothing to do with Bangladesh." Another student adds that there is little or no opportunity for research in the country. A young women said, she would just like to be able to walk back home alone at 10pm or not have to worry about eve-teasing for once.

Are the sidewalks in first world countries paved with gold? No anomaly, no strain, no injustice? Is life outside Bangladesh easy? An interviewee asks, "You can't get up before 12pm in Bangladesh and in some other country you're willing to wake up at 6am?" An expat described how Bangladeshis often face prejudice overseas. Several young professionals who have lived and studied abroad maintained that life outside the country is no cakewalk. One has to struggle everywhere.

Almost none of the 26 people, who wanted to go to Spain illegally, came from dirt-poor families. Two came from middle class families living in Dhaka. Each of them had to give the human traffickers Tk 8 lakh. Poverty surely didn't push these people to take drastic measures and risk their lives in the middle of nowhere. What then, did?

Rabul, one of the survivors of the journey, had borrowed the money to go to Spain from his relatives. He said, "If I wanted to start a business in Bangladesh, no one would give me money. When I told my relatives that I needed money to go abroad, they didn't hesitate to help. Going abroad is like a guarantee that the money will not go to waste." And that is often the common attitude. Many are convinced that Bangladesh is not a country worth living in if there is a way out.

But Dr. Zafar Iqbal asks, "If my mother is not pretty, should I start calling some easy on the eye stranger 'mother'?"

Sure there are problems but will mass migration help? Who will try to improve the conditions then?

Is unfortunate fate in a foreign country preferable to life in Bangladesh?

The documentary does lose pace at points and seems repetitive during extended dramatised scenes in between interviews. However, it does zoom in on a crucial issue. According to Mridul, *Deshantori* will soon be aired on ATN Bangla as a prequel to the upcoming TV show *Phirney Aro Bangladesh*.
