

Proceedings of tax evasion case against ex-MP Salahuddin stayed

The High Court yesterday stayed the proceedings of an income tax evasion case against detained former BNP lawmaker Salahuddin Ahmed of Demra.

Passing the interim order upon a petition, a division bench, headed by Justice M Awlad Ali, issued a rule upon the National Board of Revenue (NBR) to explain why the case pending with the special judge's court should not be quashed.

"The rule is made returnable in six weeks," said the court order.

The court order came a day before the special court, set up at the Latiya Sangsad Bhaban, was supposed to frame charges against him.

Gono Forum won't join 'opportunist' alliance

First ever sanitary landfill site inaugurated

Dhaka City Corporation (DCC) Mayor Sadeque Hossain Khoka inaugurated the country's first ever sanitary landfill site at Matuail in the city yesterday.

The project, developed with the technical support of Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), aims at capacity development of DCC to improve the solid waste management services.

The speakers hoped that after its completion, the whole landfill project will become the highest beautiful green peak around Dhaka and would offer an attractive view to the city dwellers.

Japanese Ambassador Masayuki Inoue, Resident Representative of JICA Bangladesh Nobuko Suzuki Kayashima and Prof AMM Shafiqullah, vice chancellor of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (Buet), were present at the ceremony as special guests.

Mayor Khoka said that this site is one of the major achievements of DCC. He also requested for proper utilisation and maintenance of the site.

Kayashima said the project is constructing an environmental friendly landfill site that is a milestone in this arena.

She also mentioned that DCC and JICA are working together for a common goal of realising proper solid waste management in Dhaka city.

Without efficient operation and monitoring of the surrounding environment, all the efforts of establishing this landfill will be fruitless, she added.

Buet VC AMM Shafiqullah appreciated the modern technologies introduced in the site. He said this kind of landfill sites would take the waste management system to a greater height.

Japanese Ambassador Masayuki Inoue said all the metropolitan cities of the world are having solid waste management problem.

Jamuna Group chief's detention declared illegal


The High Court (HC) yesterday declared illegal the detention of Nurul Islam Babul, chairman of Jamuna Group.

A division bench comprising Justice Shah Abu Nayeem Mumtaz and Justice Zubayer Rahman Chowdhury ordered the government to release Babul forthwith if he is not wanted in any other cases.


The order came upon a habeas corpus petition filed by Barrister Rafiqueul Huq on behalf of Babul. Babul, also the owner of daily Jugantor, was arrested on February 22 and sent to jail on detention under the Special Powers Act. He faces a number of corruption cases.
