Hamilton's Fuji win under threat

Lewis Hamilton could be stripped of his Japanese Grand Prix victory after FIA race stewards announced they were looking into the standard of his driving in the race.

The 22-year-old Briton was subjected to a torrent of abuse from Red Bull driver Mark Webber, who claimed he was driving "erratically" behind the safety car in dangerously wet conditions.

Webber claimed that Hamilton's driving, which consisted of a lot of heavy braking in huge amounts of spray, contributed to Sebastian Vettel ramming into him and ending his race.

And, during the build-up to the Chinese Grand Prix at Shanghai, a race in which Hamilton could become the first rookie world champion and the youngest in Formula One history, it emerged that he could have more of a fight on his hands than first thought.

The FIA confirmed that new evidence had emerged following the race and that it was being looked into by race stewards.

Should Hamilton be found guilty of dangerous driving, he could, in the most extreme case, be disqualified from the race.


More likely however is that he will be given a time penalty, dropping him from first place but keeping him in the points, or a ten-place grid drop for this weekend's race.



Lazio hold Real

Real Madrid were twice pegged back by Lazio in their Champions League Group C clash which ended 2-2 at the Stadio Olimpico here on Wednesday.

It was a case of doubles all round with Ruud van Nistelrooy responsible for Real's goals and Goran Pandev starting for Lazio in a match billed rather unkindly given Lazio's performance as a 'David and Goliath' clash by one of the Italian sports papers.

Real manager Bern Schuster reflected: "I'm not at all angry. It was a positive result after an open enough game. To get a point away in the Champions League is good."

His Lazio counterpart Daniel Rossi added: "The boys were extremely nervous at the idea of playing Real Madrid in front of a full stadium, and they played with lots of pride. We

succeeded in doing what we set out to achieve. We matched a team that was technically superior to us."

Real went into an eighth minute lead when van Nistelrooy turned in a free-kick from the left with his left foot for his 51st goal in the competition.

The move was started with Lazio defender Guglielmo Stendardo's ill-judged challenge on Arjen Robben.

Stendardo turned from villain to hero just after the half hour mark, when he was instrumental in the move that led to the equaliser, heading the ball into the path of Pandev.

The Macedonian striker struck it first time, his stunning left-footed volley leaving Real 'keeper Iker Casillas no chance whatsoever as the ball shot past him high into the net.

Real held on to their advantage until the 75th minute when Lazio for the second time drew back level when Pandev's left-footed strike just inside the post escaped Casillas' desperate dive.

Greek tragedy for Bremen

Werder Bremen suffered Champions League heartbreak on Wednesday night when Greek side Olympiakos fought back late to claim a 3-1 victory at the Weserstadion.

Bremen's Portuguese striker Hugo Almeida had put his side ahead when he converted a first-half cross after 32 minutes, but the Greeks hit back with Ieroklis Stolitis equalising in the 72nd minute.

The game then turned into a nightmare for the Germans when defender Christos Patsatzoglou smashed home a late shot past Werder's second-choice 'keeper Christian Vander on 82 minutes before striker Darko Kovacevic

completed the rout three minutes from time.

"If you don't enter into the fight, you haven't got a chance of winning," said glum Bremen coach Thomas Schaaf after the final whistle.

"Whether that is in the Champions League or grass-roots football, you have to compete and we didn't."

"In the first-half we weren't great, but I was happy we took a 1-0 lead."

"We lost our way, as well as the contest in the second-half, and we paid the price."

With Real Madrid drawing 2-2 with Lazio in Rome on Wednesday night, the result put Olympiakos top of Group C, but leaves Bremen bottom and in desperate need of taking at least a point from their home clash with Lazio on October 24.

The result was a set back for the

Germans who have responded with big wins over defending champions VfB Stuttgart (4-1) and Arminia Bielefeld (8-1) in the Bundesliga since their 2-1 Champions League defeat by Real Madrid last month.

They lost both goalkeeper Tim Wiese and top goal-scorer Boubacar Sanogo before kick-off with injury.

Ivory Coast striker Sanogo, who scored twice in Saturday's 8-1 demolition of Bielefeld, has struggled with a hip injury, while Wiese picked up a thigh injury and both players had struggled to train during the week.

Swedish striker Markus Rosenberg replaced Sanogo in the starting line-up while Wiese's place between the sticks went to Vander.

But Bremen welcomed back German midfielder Torsten Frings for his first game of the season since damaging knee ligaments in

a summer friendly.

The 30-year-old was greeted to thunderous applause at the Weserstadion.

Striker Hugo Almeida tested the guest's goalkeeper Antonios Nikopolidis after only five minutes, but his shot was blocked.

The home side took the lead on 32 minutes when Danish midfielder Daniel Jensen put in a dangerous cross and Almeida was waiting at the back post to put the home side 1-0 up at the break.

But Olympiakos took the lead through Stolitis and the Greek's built on their momentum when Almeida's clearance attempt fell to the feet of Patsatzoglou who smashed his shot home.

And Serbian striker Darko Kovacevic added insult with injury time approaching to put the result beyond doubt with the Greek's third goal on 87 minutes.
