

Cops struggle to tackle

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Not only do they snatch the valuables from the victims, but also make sure that the victims remember them for the rest of their lives -- if they are lucky enough to survive the ordeal -- by rubbing a type of chilli paste onto the victims' eyes or dopping them up or knocking them unconscious or even stabbing them mercilessly.

According to sources, a whopping 230 people were mugged in the city in the last two weeks. Four of them died while most others are yet to recover completely. City hospitals also saw a sharp increase in the number of patients hospitalised after falling unconscious in the streets.

Sources at Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) and Mitford Hospital told this correspondent that everyday, both hospitals have been receiving around seven to nine victims, doped up by unidentified assailants.

"More of such patients have been pouring in during the past month," said Arifur Rahman, an intern doctor at DMCH.

On July 20, Dewan Rahat Karim, a North South University (NSU) teacher, was found unconscious near the Army stadium. His eyes appeared to have been gouged out and body brutalised with cuts and abrasions to his throat.

After he was rushed to the DMCH, the doctors declared him dead. Traces of balm and chilli powder found in the victim's eyes and the face indicate that his assailants might have been members of the 'Molom Party'.

A death so tragic and brutal was awaiting Rahat Karim for a mere cellular phone and an insignificant amount of cash that he had on him on that fateful night.

The same night, unidentified criminals killed a CNG-run auto rickshaw driver, whose body was later found on Mohakhali overpass.

"Police and other law enforce-

menters claim that the law and order situation has improved, but it's only because they're looking at the statistics only. A university teacher is not a mere statistic!" said Rakib Hasan, a student at North South University, who himself was mugged last week.

"I agree they have a difficult job to do. I respect their effort, but we cannot accept the statistical interpretation of the situation. Besides, the way they are doing their job is not making life any easier. The government should be more serious about protecting peoples' lives," he added.

The anti-crime agencies are finding themselves always one

step behind the criminals due to their feeble intelligence and lack of expertise in the field, claimed police sources.

"The city is so big and I have to admit that it gets very difficult for police to catch every single criminal," said a top police official adding that with the limited facilities provided to the police, improvement in their service level is very difficult.

"We go through logistics problems, the officials have no incentives and our working conditions are not up to the mark. A constable works seven days a week for long hours and hardly gets any leave on festivals like Eid or Puja," he added.

friend's house in Tikatuli. He was hit by a raw brick, which fell on him from the fourth floor of the under construction building at Judge's Goli.

With fatal head injury, he was taken to Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) where doctors declared him dead.

According to Hridoy's family members and locals, the building owner did not take any safety precautions at and around the site of the six-storey building.

Niaz Ahmed, joint secretary of Brothers Union club, owns the under-construction building. He admitted that there

were no safety measures at the site. "I could not take safety measures because of nearby electricity lines," he said.

Alongside his study, Hridoy used to do a job to bear educational expenses of his siblings and himself with his earning. His younger sister Munni, studying in class seven, said, "Now, there is none left to bear our educational expenses and help our family."

It is too difficult to run the family with the meagre income of Hridoy's father, who is a driver in a private company, said Lili Begum, hapless mother of Hridoy.

Sub-inspector Sohel Alam of

Sutrapur Police Station investigated the incident and filed a report on Sept 15. "The accident occurred due to lack of safety precautions," said Alam.

Officer-in-charge of Sutrapur Police Station Mohammad Ali said police did not want to let the death incident go without filing a case. "On our part, we made adequate attempts to bring the death incident into due legal process," said Ali.

But the plaintiff preferred not to pursue legal process and obtained permission from a metropolitan magistrate court to take the body without post-mortem.

The Bangladesh Export Processing Zones Authority (BEPZA) is seeking 01 (one) No. of Security Consultant Cum Executive with a view to strengthening Security Department of the Dhaka/Chittagong EPZ.

1. The main task of the Security Consultant Cum-Executive:

- The Security Consultant Cum-Executive shall act as the Chief Executive of the Security Department and shall be responsible for overall security of the Zone. He shall perform his activities under the guidance of the General Manager, EPZ and General Manager (Security), BEPZA.
- He shall be responsible for maintaining and developing the total security system of the Zone.
- He shall take necessary action for up-gradation of the skills of the security personnel and strict security measures to ensure peaceful productive atmosphere in the Zone.
- He shall be responsible for drawing up a long term perspective plan for total security system and implementation of the plan as per requirement of the Zone and need of the time.
- He shall associate himself in the Industrial Relations activities particularly which relates to the safety and security of labourers and the Zone.
- He shall check and verify the present record keeping system in the Security Department, evaluate the adequacy and suggest improvement in the light of present and future requirement.
- He shall maintain liaison with the Law Enforcing Agencies, District Administration, Fire Station and other related agencies and organizations for ensuring coordinated efforts in maintaining proper security of the Zone.
- He shall conduct in house training programmes on regular basis to develop expertise and mould behavioral pattern of the security personnel to show proper courtesy while dealing with the investors and VIPs who visit the Zone from time to time.
- He shall devise a mechanism to allow the authorized persons and vehicles to enter into the Zone and prevent all unauthorized movement of goods & vehicles to and from the Zone.
- He shall control, guide and supervise all officers and staff of the Security Department and make them a strong motivating force for providing proper security of the Zone.
- He shall study the existing security system in the

- Project, analyse the existing procedures and suggest measures for improvement.
(l) Shall report any untoward incident to General Manager (Security), BEPZA and ensure compliance of BEPZA SOP on Security.
(m) Shall develop co-ordination with all security management of different enterprises within the Zone.
(n) Shall develop a warning system for any emergency security requirement within the Zone area.
(o) Shall perform any other task assigned by the Executive Chairman of BEPZA and the General Manager of the Zone from time to time.
- Qualification and Experience**
The Security Consultant Cum-Executive shall be retired Armed Forces personnel not below the rank of Major & equivalent experience in the field of security management both in Armed Forces & civil administration along with security courses & qualification will be treated as added qualification.
- Remuneration**
The monthly fees to be paid to the Security Consultant Cum-Executive shall be as per BEPZA rules (Consolidated including taxes).
- Age Limit**
No person below the age of 35 shall be eligible to apply.

Dhaka/Chittagong EPZ.

- Experience, resources and delivery capacity required are: (a) 3 (three) years overall experiences in similar assignment, (b) 2 (two) years working experiences in public sector, (c) 5 (five) years working experiences in private sector, (d) should have experience of satisfactory completion of services of value under single contract with any one of the last five years is Tk 5.00 (five) lakh, (e) Institutional capacity for supervision all over Bangladesh, (f) Should have available experienced/qualified staff for the assignment.

- The Line Director (Procurement, Storage and Supply Management (Family Planning)) now invites eligible applicants to indicate their interest in providing the services.
