

Floods wreak havoc on Gaibandha rails, roads

Officials estimate Tk 33cr damage to infrastructures

Floods that hit Gaibandha district twice this year caused extensive damage to road and rail communication.

The Railway and the Roads and Highways Department (R&H) have primarily estimated the flood damage to infrastructures at around Tk 33.39 crore, officials said.

The floods badly damaged 4,089 kilometer roads in five upazilas of Gaibandha district. The worst affected are Gaibandha-Fulchari, Gaibandha-Saghat, Gaibandha-Balashi Ghat, Gaibandha-Kamajani, Gaibandha-Sadullapur, Gaibandha-Sunderganj and Gobindganj-Ghoraghat roads under the R&H and LGED departments.

Over 250 metres of Gaibandha-Balashi road in Falia area and 100 metres of the Gaibandha-Kalirbazar road were washed away by surging water.

Six bridges including the 80 metre bridge on Alai river at Badiakhali on Gaibandha-Bonarpara road collapsed during the flood, the officials said.

According to LGED officials, the floods damaged 57.42 kilometres pucca road, 116.69 kilometres kutcha roads and 11 bridges. The department estimated the loss at Tk 9.79 crore.

LGED executive engineer in Gaibandha has sent an estimate of Tk 17 crore to higher authorities for renovation of damaged roads and bridges. The department has allocated

only Tk 10 lakh, officials said.

The Roads and Highway Department has sought Tk 12.10 crore for reconstruction of damaged roads in different upazilas.

According to Railway authorities, eight out of nine kilometer rail track between Trimohony-Balashi Ghat were damaged by flood. Transshipment of goods in this section of railway

remained suspended for three months and it will take two months more to restore rail link, high officials of railway in Lalmonirhat said when contacted.

Disruption in the railway communication caused sufferings to people and losses to traders and farmers.

The authorities said they are trying to renovate the damaged roads as soon as possible.



3-day Lalon Mela starts in Kushtia

Bauls and devotees of Lalon have started arriving at Chheuria from across the country.

EXTORTION CASE AGAINST NASER RAHMAN

2 R&H engineers sent to jail on surrender

A court in Sylhet sent Roads & Highways (R&H) Department executive engineers Abdul Khaleque Miah and Shafiqul Islam to jail on surrender yesterday.

Additional District and Sessions Judge Binoy Kumar Majumder in a verdict on September 18 gave five years' simple imprisonment to Abdul Khaleque Miah and Shafiqul Islam in an extortion case against them and former BNP lawmaker Naser Rahman, son of former finance minister Saifur Rahman.

Naser Rahman was given nine

years imprisonment in the case. The two engineers were tried in absentia. Moulvibazar BNP vice-president Wali Siddique, a close aide to Naser, was also given five years' imprisonment in the same case.

The judge however acquitted Moulvibazar Pourashava chairman and district BNP secretary Foizul Karim Moyun and R & H sub-divisional engineer Monwar Sadique of charges in the case.

Contractor Nuruzzaman filed the extortion case on February 17 against Naser Rahman and six others including the two engineers.

AL leader held for 'extortion'

Detective Branch (DB) arrested Khoksa upazila Awami League (AL) president Sadar Uddin Khan, also a former upazila chairman, on Friday midnight.

The court sent Sadar to jail after police produced him before the court on Saturday.

Sadar Khan was arrested following an extortion case filed by Maqbul Master, another AL leader in the upazila, police said.

In the case filed with Khoksa Police Station several days ago, Maqbul alleged that Sadar Khan demanded Tk 2 lakh from him two years ago.

He paid Tk 1 lakh but Sadar continued to threaten him with dire consequences in case of failure to pay the rest of the money, he added.

The project to 'Enhance the Capacity of Department of Livestock Services', is recruiting a long-term National Adviser for a period of 05 years. The position is based in the Department of Livestock Services (DLS), under the Ministry of Fisheries and Livestock. The project is part of the Regional Fisheries and Livestock Development Component (RLFDC) of the Agricultural Sector Programme Support Phase II (2006-2011), which is implemented by the Government of Bangladesh with support from the Danish International Development Assistance (Danida). The project in DLS is managed by a National Project Director (PD), supported by an International Senior Adviser (SA) and national staff. Bangladesh nationals are invited to apply for the position.

National Adviser (01 full-time post)

The National Adviser will work closely with the Project Director on a daily basis. The key responsibilities and duties are:

- To support the respective departments in the implementation of the strategies and action plans outlined in the recent sector reviews and policy documents (Livestock Sector Review and Future Development Study; Livestock Policy and Action Plan);
- To advise the respective departments in their mandates and in the provision of public goods (policy formulation, development of legislative and regulatory frameworks, setting directions for strategic research, quality control for inputs and products);
- To assist relevant government staff in the development and management of an integrated MIS, allowing the departments to make informed policy decisions on the basis of the assessment of ongoing trends. This will include monitoring, evaluation and documentation of filed sub-component activities.
- To develop curricula for different training programme relation to HRD of DLS;
- To organise different training programme;
- To promote coordination of activities with the field level DPP;
- To identify TA needs for sub-component implementation together with the PD and SA and other relevant persons/institutions. This would include the drafting of TOR, as well as contracting and supervision of international and national short-term consultants;
- In cooperation with PD and SA maintain contact to other projects relevant to RFLD activities at both national and field levels in order to explore possibilities for coordination and harmonisation of strategies and procedures;
- Through participation in the PSC to promote coordination and integration of public sector extension activities in the livestock sub-sectors;
- Jointly with the PD and SA hold responsibility for the operation of the Department Support Unit, including financial and personnel management and administration;
- Jointly with the PD and SA, coordinate the planning and budgeting process and prepare semi-annual plans and budgets to be approved by the PSC;
- Jointly with the PD, be responsible for monitoring sub-component implementation and the preparation of financial and progress reporting;
- Prepare short issues-oriented reports as required for discussion of specific issues for Programme Steering Committee meetings, LCG meetings, and by the EOD, or with other relevant stakeholders. This would include information on lessons learned during implementation of sub-component interventions;
- Be responsible to PD, SA and to the EOD for proper utilisation and management of financial and material resources provided by Danida for implementation of sub-component activities;
- Work closely with PD and Senior Adviser on all matters to ensure a smooth transition of responsibilities;
- Carry out other tasks as requested by the departments and/or the EOD.

The position requires knowledge and experience in both technical and policy issues in Livestock especially rural based Livestock development programme. Thus, candidates are expected to have the following educational background and working experiences:

- Education at university level (Masters or Doctoral) in Veterinary Science/Animal Husbandry.
- Extensive working experience in development planning and policy formulation in the sector, especially in Asia.
- Inter-personal skills with high level of initiative and diplomacy.
- Capacity to manage and facilitate work processes involving parties at different levels.
- Fluency in spoken and written English.

The position carries a basic salary starting at BDT 57,239/month plus other benefit as admissible.
