

5 bombs, arms recovered in Pabna, Benapole

Law enforcers recovered five bombs and some firearms in Pabna and Benapole yesterday.

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) and police recovered a bomb from the premises of Pabna Diabetic Hospital in the morning, our correspondent reports.

The bomb with red tapes strapped around contained in a polythene bag was seen by hospital staff at about 9 am. On information, Rab personnel and police rushed to the spot and recovered it.

They took it away in a bucket of water. The incident created a panic in the hospital area.

None was arrested. Police said they are interrogating some hospital staff.

A special team from Rab-6 recovered four bombs, a pistol and two bullets hidden in a straw heap near the house of one Md Asaduzzaman Asha at Dhankhola village under Benapole police station in Jessore.

After recovery, the bombs were defused while the pistol and the bullets were handed over to police, said a press release issued by Rab-6, our Staff Correspondent in Khulna reports.

It said Rab and police are investigating the matter. None was arrested.

Freedom fighter elected secretary of Khulna Shishu Foundation

Ex-BNP MP accused of grabbing Tk 15cr

Nitai demands probe into Salimul Huq's 'corruption'

Former minister and BNP central leader Nitai Roy Chowdhury has alleged that former party lawmaker Quazi Salimul Huq alias Quazi Kamal and his cronies grabbed at least Tk 15 crore through tender manipulation in different government departments during the alliance rule.

The manipulations were done by a syndicate styled 'negotiation committee' led by him, Nitai said while talking to this correspondent.

He also demanded probe into various corruption and irregularities done by Quazi Kamal and his aides. Quazi Kamal was elected from Magura-2 constituency. He is chairman of Econo Ball Pen Company.

Quazi Kamal, convener of Magura district unit BNP, is on the run after Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) on May 29 filed a bribery case against him with Shabbag police station in Dhaka. Nitai Roy is joint-convener of Magura BNP.

In the case, the ACC alleged that Quazi Kamal along with detained former state minister for communications Salahuddin Ahmed realised Tk 1 crore bribe from contractor Mir Zahir Hossain to help him get a business, according to ACC sources and police here. Metropolitan Sessions Judge in Dhaka Mohammad Azizul Huq on September 16 ordered attachment of Salimul's property for not appearing before the court.

Earlier, in 2006, at a meeting

held on the occasion of BNP's founding anniversary at Magura Government College premises, Nitai accused Quazi Kamal of grabbing huge amounts of money through tender manipulation and other illegal means.

Industrialist turned lawmaker Quazi Kamal then filed a defamation suit against Nitai Roy.

"I was sued by Kamal as I protested their corruption and irregularities, but now it has been proved that I was right," Nitai said.

"Many of our party men have now raised voices against their misdeeds that defamed our popular organization," Nitai said.

During alliance rule Quazi Kamal and his aides formed a syndicate styled 'negotiation committee' and manipulated tenders for development projects of most government departments. They also 'occupied' water bodies and markets in the name of lease, Nitai said.

During alliance rule, no professional contractors had entry to any government department to buy or

drop schedules without permission of the syndicate led by Kamal, he said.

They distributed development works, markets and water bodies in exchange of money, the former minister told.

They syndicate realised 16 per cent money of the estimated cost of development projects, he alleged.

Six per cent of the money was deposited with the account of 'Quazi Salimul Huq Trust', a social welfare body named after his mother and the rest were grabbed by his cronies, Nitai Roy said.

In this way they realised at least Tk 15 crore in last five years, he claimed.

They also realised money in appointment of primary school teachers and persons in health department.

"In my opinion, all the irregularities done by Quazi Kamal and his cronies should be investigated and stern action should be taken so that in future no body dares to do such offenses," Nitai Roy said.

RU VIOLENCE PW Prof Islam declared 'hostile'

Rajshahi speedy trial court yesterday recorded deposition of the tenth prosecution witness (PW) in the case against six Rajshahi University teachers for violating the Emergency Power Rules 2007.

The PW, Prof M Khademul Islam, chairman of mass communication department of RU, was however, declared 'hostile' at the court following the prayer of court sub-inspector Shamsul Islam.

The PW had stated before the court that he did not know the plaintiff and neither did he know anything about involvement of the teachers in the alleged incidents.

The six accused teachers -- former RU vice chancellor Dr M Saidur Rahman Khan, syndicate member Dr M Abbas Sobhan, Moloy Bhoomik, Dulal Chandra Biswas, Sayed Selim Reza Newton and Abdullah Al Mamun -- were also produced before the court.

The teachers were charged for violating the EPR through holding protest procession, observing strike and instigating the late August campus violence.

Former officer-in-charge of Motihar Police Station Khondoker Ferdous Alam lodged the case against three teachers on August 26.

Later on September 1, investigation officer in the case, sub-inspector Nasir Uddin Mondol pressed charges against six teachers and the court framed charges on September 17.

EU team to visit Khulna shrimp centres Oct 21, 22

Exporters of frozen shrimp are making preparations to welcome a four-member EU inspection team that will visit shrimp cultivation and processing centres in Khulna and Bagerhat districts on October 21 and 22.

The team will inspect shrimp landing centre of Fakirhat and a shrimp enclosure at Rampal upazila of Bagerhat district on October 21.

The EU team will also visit the

laboratory of quality control section of Khulna Fisheries Office and two shrimp processing factories in Rupsha upazila of the district, said Sheikh Abdul Baki, vice president of Bangladesh Frozen Food Exporters' Association (BFFEA).

Their Khulna programme will be followed by visits to two or three factories and hatcheries in Bagerhat district on October 22, the BFFEA leaders said.

Report on findings of the EU Food and Veterinary Mission determines the fate of export of shrimps

and other frozen foods worth over Tk 2,000 crore a year, he said.

Such a team from the EU visited Bangladesh in November 2005 to inspect frozen shrimp processing factories.

The European Union slapped a ban on shrimp export from Bangladesh in 1997 as processed frozen shrimp carried bacterial germs.

EU has been keeping sharp watch on the quality of Bangladeshi frozen shrimp since the ban on its export was withdrawn after six months.

311 legalise Tk 3.66cr income in Moulvibazar. Scores with undeclared income yet to be detected, officials say

As many as 311 people have legalised their undeclared Tk 3 crore 66 lakh income in the entire district.

Taking advantage of flexibility of the National Board of Revenue (NBR), the defaulters paid Tk 1 crore 73 lakh as tax for the purpose. They included businessmen, physicians, lawyers and expatriates.

But, it was learnt from the office of the Commissioner of Taxes of Sylhet, the number of defaulting businessmen and

expatriates would be much more.

A large number of people of the district live in USA, UK, Canada and the Middle Eastern countries.

Besides, the district has forest resources. Local people said, a large number of people who were involved in politics became rich by trading with forest resource in the last 15 years.

Others have become moneyed persons with their involvement in money laundering. Many of them did not legalise their undisclosed money, said an income tax official.

The Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) yesterday filed cases against 11 commissioners of Kashba pourasabha in Brahmanbaria district for corruption and causing loss of government revenue.

Shaheen Ara Mamataz, assistant director of ACC in Brahmanbaria, filed the cases with Kashba Police Station following investigation of a written complaint filed by Commissioner Tajul Islam seven months ago.

The accused are -- Abul Hossain, Md Jasim Uddin, Md Akter Hossain, Md Hiran Mia, Md Shahidul Islam,

Md Farook Ahmed, Nurunnabi Dulal, Nizam Uddin Sarker, Shilpy Akter, Anwar Begum and Ayesha Akter. Kashba police arrested the first five of them yesterday.

The accused commissioners committed different types of corruption including the leasing of

shops at low rates and causing loss of government money, the ACC officials said.

The name of another accused, pourasava administrator Md Rafiqul Islam, could not be included in the cases as he died on April 17, said an ACC source.
