The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the implementation of second phase of procurement reform through Public Procurement Reform Project II (PPRP II) and it intends to apply part of the proceeds for the provision of consultancy services for the project by hiring two individual national consultants: Project Procurement Consultant (PPC) and Electronic Government Procurement (e-GP) Consultant.

Project Procurement Consultant: (Duration: Four years)

Task:

The services, among others, include the following:

- Help implementation of all aspects of procurement under the project.
- Develop and update procurement plan for the project.
- Assist the implementing agency to prepare invitation for bids, request for expressions of interest, bidding documents, request for proposals, evaluation reports, contracts, and other procurement and project related documents.
- Provide assistance on procurement matters to ensure consistent application of the Procurement/Consultants' Guidelines of the World Bank and The Public Procurement Regulations 2003 (PPR) and/or Public Procurement Act 2006 (PPA) as appropriate.
- Work as member of the bid/proposal evaluation committee for large value contract.
- Closely monitor procurement progress and prepare quarterly report on procurement status and procurement risk mitigation framework.
- Assist CPTU in reviewing project implementation and capacity development reports, and in preparing TORs for other relevant tasks.
- Support the target agencies as regards PPRP II procurement matters, if necessary.

Qualification and experience:

- Graduate/Post-graduate qualification (at least Bachelors in Engineering or Masters in procurement/ commerce/ finance/ business/management/law or suitable equivalency).
- At least eight years of experience as Procurement Specialist or have had responsibilities with a substantial content of his/her position in the procurement area (use of internationally accepted contract documents for works, goods and services; sound understanding of principles underlying good procurement practices and international agencies' procurement guidelines; understanding of Government's Procurement Regulations/Act; analytical capability in identifying and resolving procurement issues).
- Specialised knowledge of and significant experience in 2-3 substantive areas/aspects of procurement (e.g. procurement of goods; various forms of construction contracts; selection/contracting of consultant services; preparation of bidding/contract documents for the international procurement of goods, works, services; public procurement policies; practices).
- Sound knowledge and skill in applications of various computer packages. Understanding of IT related field and technical, commercial and legal aspects of procurement of the World Bank-financed project will be an added advantage.
- Strong communication skills in presenting, discussing and resolving difficult issues. Ability to work efficiently and effectively in a multidisciplinary team.

e-GP/MIS Consultant (Duration: Four years)

Tasks:

The services, among others, include the following:

- Assist CPTU in all Electronic Government Procurement (e-GP) related activities.
- Review the current Procurement Management Information System (PROMIS) applications and infrastructure of CPTU.
- Review the present IT infrastructure, management information system, contract reporting system of the four target agencies (LGED, RHD, RIEB & BWBD).
- Assist e-GP international consultant to develop the integration mechanism of PROMIS with the contract management software of the target agencies.
- Suggest the modification/upgradation of existing PROMIS for effective data input in PROMIS by the target agencies without any double entry.
- Prepare the hardware, software and resource requirement with detail cost estimation for the target agencies to support e-GP and PROMIS.
- Prepare a detail action plan for the implementation of the required IT infrastructure for the target agencies. Supervise the progress of the implementation of the IT infrastructure for the target agencies.
- Provide e-GP related technical support to the target agencies.
- Assist e-GP international consultant to develop (i) system architecture within the context of the Bangladesh Government e-GP strategy, (ii) develop the TOR for the engagement of an external developer for the development of the e-GP system as specified by the CPTU, (iii) evaluate proposals from consulting firm (external developer), and (iv) supervise the implementation of e-GP system so developed.

Qualification and Experience

- Bachelor in Engineering/Information Technology/Management Information System (MIS) or suitable equivalency.
- At least five years of experience as Electronic Procurement Specialist or IT Specialist MIS specialist with proven track record in designing MIS or have had responsibilities with a substantial content of his/her position in the design of electronic/IT systems.
- Sound knowledge and skill in all applications of computer packages. Understanding of procurement contents and its relevance to IT field will be an added advantage.
- Strong communication skills in presenting, discussing and resolving difficult IT/technical issues. Ability to work efficiently and effectively in a multidisciplinary team.

The Central Procurement Technical Unit (CPTU) now invites eligible applicants to indicate their interest in providing the services. Applicants are invited to provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (complete CV with expected remuneration).

Detailed terms of reference (TOR) will be available upon request from the address provided below either through email or in person.

The consultants will be selected using the selection of individual consultant in accordance with the current World Bank's Consultants Guidelines. It is expected that services will be commenced in December 2007 at Dhaka, Bangladesh and shall be completed on December 2011. Consultant's contract duration of four years will be subject to satisfactory performance to be evaluated annually.

Expressions of Interest shall be submitted by 23/12/2007 either in sealed envelope or through email sent to Director General, and be clearly marked "Expressions of Interest for Individual Consultant/Project Procurement Consultant or e-GP Consultant", as the case may be.
