Victory Day celebration begins

Weeklong programme at Liberation War Museum

LIBERATION War Museum's (LWM) weeklong programme on the occasion of our Victory Day began on December 10 at the museum premises. Mafidul Haque, one of the museum trustees, presented the main speech at the event. Another trustee and eminent cultural personality Aly Zaker delivered the welcome speech.

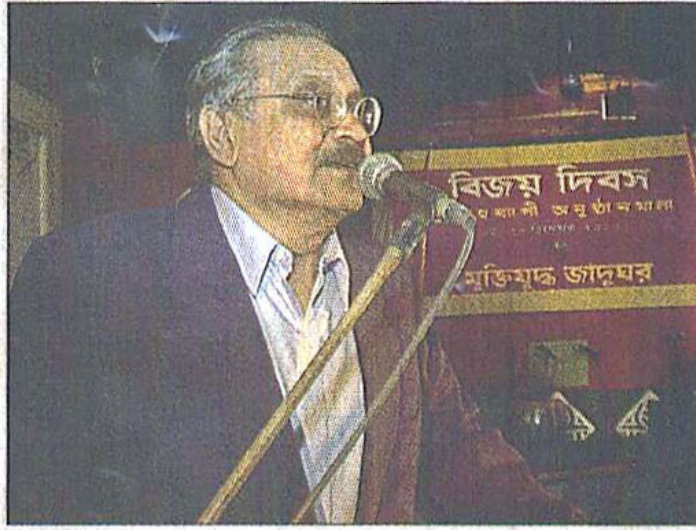
December 10, marks the 60th anniversary of United Nation's historic Genocide Convention, which is significant for Bangladesh, surviving a brutal genocide.

In his speech titled "60th anniversary of Genocide Convention and Bangladesh", Mafidul Haque said, "According to the Genocide Convention, the government of the state as well as the UN are responsi-

ble to initiate the trials of war criminals. However, we have not found any initiative as of yet in our country."

Aly Zaker said, "The generation that experienced and lived through the war has seen what the Pakistani army, and their collaborators Razakar, Al Badr and Al Shams had done to the unarmed civilians. Now decades after, there is a conscious effort to establish an 'altered' history that says no mass murder, torture or abuse occurred during the war. It is high time that we take a stance against the war criminals and get the world to acknowledge that our nation survived a genocide."

At the cultural programme that followed, children of Arani Bidyalaya and Engineers' Institute Girls School performed patriotic songs, recitation and dance. A solo

dance performance by Silva from Engineers' Institute Girls School delighted the audience.

Students of the University of Liberal Arts Bangladesh (ULAB) also participated at the event. They staged a short play by eminent playwright and poet Syed Shamsul Haque, titled Judho Ebong Judho.

Dhaka Theatre performed a brief version of their latest production Nimajon by Selim Al Deen. The play highlights the theme that every civilisation stands on the bones of people killed in genocides. "The play is a tribute to the victims of genocides that occurred all over the world since human civilisation began," said Nasiruddin Yousuff, the director of the play.

The 32-minute version of the play was an "artistic representation of the message that the Liberation War Museum wants to convey," said Mafidul Haque, bringing an end to the first day's programme. The event will continue till December 16.

Voices of the others

Rongberong stages play on Intersex community

To mark the Human Rights Day, 'Rongberong', the theatre group of Badhan Hijra Sangha (an organisation working with the intersex community in Bangladesh), staged a play titled Amra Manush, Chai Manusher Adhikar at the Engineers' Institute Auditorium, Dhaka. Rongberong is the only theatre troupe representing the hijra community.

In our country, the general impression of the intersex community is not positive. They are considered 'outsiders', forced to live on the fringes of society. They are often denied of the basic human rights.

Written and directed by Subas Biswas Shuvo, the play featured various issues -- social isolation of the intersex community in our country, discrimination by the society, prostitution and risks of HIV transmission and more. The play was staged with an aim to generate awareness on the intersex community.

Rongberong was founded in 2005. The troupe works to generate awareness through plays. In our society people show very little interest in the lives of hijras. Ignorance results to misunderstanding and mistreatment. Rongberong wants to circulate the message that hijras have just as much rights as anyone else in the society.

This was the third production by the troupe. Proceeds from the show will be donated to the Sidr victims.

Rongberong staged their first play Modhyobartini on March 2006. The second production was staged on December 1, 2006, on World AIDS Day. The group has also staged some street plays.

Prior to the play, a brief discussion was held. Pinky Sikder, president of Badhan Hijra Sangha delivered the welcome speech. Theatre personality Asaduzzaman Noor and Dr. Sharful Islam Khan, associate scientist of ICDDR, B were also present at the occasion.

"Amina Shundori": The age-old story of a woman wronged

As done in the indigenous performing art form pala, a gayen (lead singer) and his choir start the play Amina Shundori, with bandona (devotional intro). Subsequently the choir begins narrating the story of Amina, a woman who has been wronged. Amina's tragedy is not an alien case; her story represents the ongoing maltreatment women receive everywhere -- disregard of their unconditional love by their hypocrite husbands and continual deception.

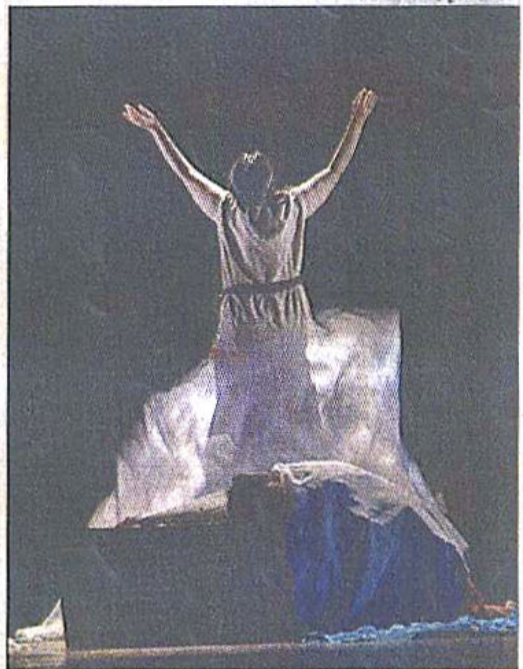
Adapted by S.M. Solaiman from the 300-year-old folklore Nasor Mahum O Bhehua Shundori (collected by Ashutosh Chowdhury), Amina Shundori was staged by three troupes. Theatre Art Unit premiered Amina Shundori, directed by Rokeya Rafiq Baby, on December 10 at the National Theatre Stage. Earlier, the play was staged by two directors for different troupes. S.M. Solaiman had directed the play at one point as well.

The story of Amina Shundori is quite simple: Soon after marrying Amina, her husband goes to Burma (Myanmar) and marries another woman named Akin. Amina's struggle as an abandoned wife begins; yet she patiently awaits the return of her husband. She has to confront the lechers, who want to marry her.

Rokeya Rafiq Baby's treatment of the play differs from the earlier productions. The directorial composition is experimental -- the director has blended the music-dance-acting based indigenous theatre form with the western Stanislavskian methodology where the actors' movements on the stage are geometrical. And the geometrically shaped symbolic set by Shahinur Rahman enriched the aesthetic aspect of the play, set against the backdrop of a coastal area.

USP of Baby's directorial compositions are smooth transition of scenes and portrayal of one character by several actors: Three artistes play Amina in the production.

Like the other folklore-based theatre productions, music has been used as the dominant element in the play. Music composer Selim Mahubb's fusion of popular folk songs such as Amar golar haar and kando kemon with classical tunes deserves praise. The experiment with rhythm and tempo as per demand of the sequences works.

Light designer Faiz Zahir's use of colour effects on the cyclorama helped create the apt ambience.

The spirited performance by the actors of Theatre Art Unit turned this story as old as time into a remarkable experience. Farida Lima's portrayal of Amina deserves plaudits, particularly in the scene where her husband Nasor finds her captive at a sailor's home. Her expressions of anger and grief upon hearing Nasor question her chastity seemed to strike a chord with the audience.

Selim Mahubb as gayen delivered a commendable performance. Shimul Khan's portrayals of Amina and Kazi, Chhandan Reza as the elderly Munaf Kazi, Ilma Hossain as Akin and Ejaz as Darmis performed boldly on the stage.

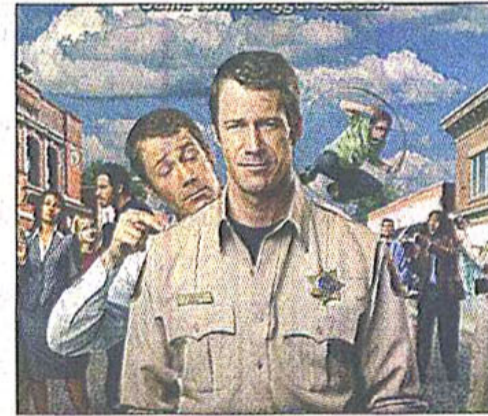
