Martyred Intellectuals' Day observed in dists

Martyred Intellectuals' Day was observed in districts yesterday with a call for trial of war criminals.

Freedom fighters joined by cultural activists, professionals and people from all walks of life formed human chains and held discussion meetings demanding trial and punishment of killers of intellectuals.

Our RU Correspondent reports: In Rajshahi, the day's programme began in the morning with placing of wreath at the Central Shaheed Minar by Vice Chancellor (VC) Prof Dr. Alfar Hossain.

Pro VC Prof Mamunul Keramat, teachers and high officials of the university were present there. Rajshahi University Teachers' Association (RUTA), cultural organisations and hall authorities also placed wreaths at the Shaheed Minar.

National flag was hoisted at half-mast atop the administrative building, VC's house and dormitories. RUTA brought out a procession on the campus. Its president Prof Zillur Rahman led the procession. A discussion was held at Jubilee Bhabon.

Shaheed Smriti Sangrasala organised an art competition at the Shaheed Minar.

Special prayers were offered after Johar prayers at the university central mosque. Shaheed Smriti Sangrasala remained open for visitors till evening.

Another report says: Famous dramatist and president of Bangladesh Group Theater Federation and Mukto Natak Dal Mamunur Rashid called for unity of all patriotic and progressive forces of the country for trial and punishment of war criminals. He was addressing a discussion at the Shaheed Minar.

Muktijodha Command Council also organized another discussion at the same venue.

Earlier, Mamunur Rashid placed wreath at the Shaheed Minar and observed two-minute silence in memory of martyred intellectuals. Later, he placed wreath at the mass graves on the campus. He also met four teachers of the university who were released from jail recently.

Our Dinajpur Correspondent reports: Bangladesh Sector Commanders Forum and cultural activists here formed a human chain. This was followed by a discussion in front of Dinajpur Udichi Complex in the afternoon where speakers urged the government to try war criminals under the existing law.

In another meeting, Dinajpur unit of Bangladesh Muktijodha Sangsad also demanded punishment to the war criminals.

Among others, Sammilito Sangkrit Jote convener Miza Anwarul Islam Tanu, Md Rezaur Rahman, Biman Biswas and Md. Mosaddeque Ali Mongolia spoke on the occasion.

Our Satkhira Correspondent reports: Over 400 freedom fighters, in response to call of Sector Commanders' Forum, formed a human chain on Shaheed Kajar Sarani in front of Muktijodha Sangsad office here yesterday.

Later, a discussion was held at

the Muktijodha Sangsad office. Sangsad district command unit convenor Matir Rahman was in the chair.

Among others, freedom fighters Prof Abu Ahmed, MA Khaleque, Magfur Rahman and Abu Bakkar Siddique, Kazi Riaz, Abdul Bari, Jalal Uddin, Abdul Hai, Advocate Nurul Alam, Azibar Rahman and Saiful Karim Sabu addressed.

Our Manikganj Correspondent reports: Freedom fighters and people of all walks of life formed a human chain at Garpara Arjabanu High School ground where martyred Chan Mia was laid to rest. The two-minute human chain was formed demanding trial of war criminals.

About 200 people including teachers, students, lawyers, journalists and farmers participated. Manikganj district Awami League (AL) President Golam Mohiuddin, its General Secretary Gazi Kamrul Huda Selim, Central Unit of Jatiya Somajtantrik Dal (JSD-Inu) Joint Secretary Iqbal

Hossain Khan, President of Manikganj Chamber of Commerce and Industry Mahbubul Alam Runu, AL leaders Badrul Islam Bablu, Hasib Uddin Ahmed Selim, BNP leader Azad Hossain Khan, JSD leader Abdus Sattar joined the human chain.

At another memorial meeting at the school, Biplob, a nephew of martyred Chan Mia, urged the authorities concerned to make a museum for protecting his memory.

Our Pabna Correspondent reports: A discussion was held at Pabna Press Club. Press Club president Rumi Khondokar presided.

Among others, journalists Anwarul Haque, Rabiul Islam Rabi, Utpol Mirza, Shahidur Rahman, Ahmed Ul Haque Rana and Prof Shibojit Nag addressed.

Earlier, Pabna Press Club, Sammilito Shangskritik Jote, and Bijoy Mela committee laid wreaths at the alter of 'Duroj Pabna' and Liberation War Memorial.

2 outlaws held in Kushtia

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) arrested three criminals and recovered firearms in two separate raids in the district on Thursday night.

A Rab team raided a den of outlawed Biplobi Communist Party at Ballapur village in Sadar upazila in the district and arrested Anwar Hossain, 45, and Selim, 36.

Two Indian made shutter guns and four bullets were recovered from their possession, Rab said.

Another Rab team raided Khasmathurapur village in Daulatpur upazila at about 11:00pm, arrested Mamun of gang group Lalchad Bahini and recovered a light gun. He is accused in several cases for murder and abduction, police said.

Doctor hurt in bomb attack

A rural medical practitioner was seriously injured as criminals blasted bombs at Goshnagar Bazar under the Sadar upazila on Wednesday night.

The victim is identified as Yunus Ali, 40, of Goshnagar village in the Sadar upazila.

Earlier on December 9, Anwar Hossain, 32, of Dhobapala village under Jhenidaha Sadar, was killed as criminals bombed and shot him at Shishutala near the village, police said.

Anwar, was once an activist of Purbo Banglar Communist Party (PBCP), joined BNP.

ALIM JUTE MILL

Workers' hunger strike today to realise arrears

Workers and employees of laid-off Alim Jute Mill will observe hunger strike from 6am to 6pm in front of the mill gate today as part of a programme to realise their arrears dues and withdrawal of the lay-off.

They have threatened tough agitation including putting up barricades on Khluna-Jessore highway at different points on Monday to be followed by self immolation by a group of workers if the authorities fail to meet their demand by the Sunday deadline, given earlier.

The workers are left with no alternative to such tough agitation programmes, said Alim Jute Mill CBA leader Abdul Hamid as the management is neither withdraw-

ing the lay-off nor paying their arrears.

The workers and employees along with those who opted for quitting jobs under Voluntary Retirement Scheme (VRS) announced the Sunday deadline and the agitation program on Thursday to press their demands.

To make the programmes successful, workers' leaders exchanged views with cross-sections of people at the mill workers' union office yesterday, sources said.

Earlier, on August 12, 801 out of 811 workers, 50 out of 57 employees and 6 out of 20 officials of the mill applied to the management to quit their jobs under VRS.

The management on October 1 accepted applications of 223 work-

ers and 45 employees, allowing them to quit jobs under VRS.

But neither the laid-off workers nor those under VRS were paid their dues, the sources said.

Project Director of the mill, Monowar Hossain, expressed the authorities' inability to fulfill the demands due to non-allocation of fund.

He said Alim Jute Mill was a profitable enterprise though burdened with debts of nearly Tk 120 crore including arrear wages and salaries, bonus, layoff benefits, provident fund and gratuity of workers and employees.

The mill was first laid-off on September 22. The management extended the lay-off three times. The last lay-off notice was issued on December 6.

Victory memorial not opened in 2 years

Names of fake FFs, Razakar still on plaque

Two years after construction, the victory memorial on the compound of Satkhira Collectorate is yet to be inaugurated as names of fake freedom fighters and a razakar are still on the plaque containing the names of martyred freedom fighters.

Faced with protest by freedom fighters and pro-liberation forces, the authorities could not inaugurate the memorial built in 2005 as names of four fake freedom fighters and a razakar (collaborator of Pakistan occupation forces) were included on the victory memorial plaque.

The Liberation War Affairs Ministry is yet to erase the names despite submission of written application and a memorandum by the Satkhira district Muktijodha Sangsad in 2006 and this year.

The memorial plaque contains names of 31 freedom fighters but names of many other martyred freedom fighters have been left out, local leaders of Bangladesh Muktijodha Sangsad said.

The plaque contains the names

of at least four fake freedom fighters and a razakar, said Abu Bakkar Siddique, member secretary of Satkhira district command of Bangladesh Muktijodha Sangsad. Freedom fighters have urged

the government to inaugurate the memorial after removing the names of a razakar and four fake freedom fighters as early as possible so that people can pay homage to the martyrs.

Signs of massacre disappearing

Planned 8 monuments yet to be built in Mouilvibazar

No monument has been built in the eight selected spots in the district which bear horrifying memories of massacre by Pakistani occupation forces during Liberation War.

The then government is 1991 selected the eight spots from among 56 'slaughter places' and mass-graves in Mouilvibazar for construction of monuments but nothing has been done.

The spots were chosen by a joint team of Bangladesh army and district administration at the initiative of the ministry of liberation war affairs to preserve the history of war in Mouilvibazar.

During the war, Pakistani occupation forces and their collaborators brought several hundred

freedom fighters and innocent people from different areas and killed them in the 56 spots. The bodies were buried in mass graves.

These spots were identified by local people after independence. These are at Kamalpur and Noria village in Sadar upazila, Panchgaon village in Rajnagar upazila, bank of Hakatir Dighi in Kulaura upazila, eastern side of rail track at Kulaura railway station in, Saypur in Baralekha upazila, Shamsenagar airport in Kamalganj upazila and Varaura in Srimongal upazila.

Due to negligence, these places of history of our liberation are being encroached or signs erected there by local people are being destroyed, sources in the district

Muktijodha Sangsad said.

Muktijodha Sangsad leaders and the then district administration prepared statements of land owners, drew sketch of the proposed monuments at these spots and took initiative to acquire lands in 1999.

But later, the initiative died down for reasons not known.

Only a small structure was built on the mass grave at Shamsenagar airport which was a 'place for slaughter' during the war. The rest seven spots are as they were after Liberation.

Mouilvibazar Additional Deputy Commissioner (General) Md Jahangeer Kabir, when contacted, said there is no initiative now to build monuments at the eight spots.

Another barge mounted power plant closed down at Goalpara

The last of the two 14-megawatt barge-mounted power plant of Khulna Power Station (KPS) at Goalpara in the city has been finally closed down.

As barge mounted power plant No 2 remained unable to generate electricity since December 3 due to irreparable technical problems, it has been closed down as a 'condemned plant' following orders from Power Development Board (PDB) head office, said Chief Engineer Abdul Khaleque.

Earlier on December 4, Executive Engineer (Mechanical) Zahidur Rashid and Executive Engineer (Operation) Shahiduzzaman wrote to Chief Engineer Khaleque recommending closure


of barge mounted power plant No 2, KPS sources said.

Another 14-MW barge-mounted power plant of KPS has remained out of order since August 27 due to a major technical fault.

The 60MW power plant of KPS has also remained inoperative since July 5 last year.

The lone 110MW power plant of KPS now in operation is not also able to produce more than 55 to 60 megawatt of electricity a day due to some technical reasons, KPS sources said, adding that the entire south-western region will reel under severe power outage if the 110MW plant goes out of order.

The region is now getting only 250 to 300 MW against the need of 550 to 600 MW during peak hour.
