

## Spruce up for Christmas

In the end, if you are searching for something special to spruce up your home for Christmas then make some small innovative changes which will entertain all on this special day.




## Christmas buys

**A**colourful Christmas with thousands of twinkling lights, shimmering ornaments and sparkling Christmas trees is a spectacular candy for the eye. You can choose from hundreds of different styles, colours, designs and themes, and the temptation is often to choose a bit of everything and end up in a horrible mess. This week's shoptalk thus focuses on the essential Christmas décor that the town has to offer.

Almost all of us who celebrate Christmas will put up a Christmas tree of some kind. It is one of the most recognisable symbols of Christmas. Since the real Pine is not available in Dhaka, you have to settle for the artificial one made of jute or plastic. Folk International can be one of your places to buy a Christmas tree for Tk 2700 to Tk 3750 depending on the size. Otherwise you can go for a random search

through DCC markets in Gulshan.

Once you have a Christmas tree, you can start decorating it by arranging the filler ornaments evenly spaced around the tree. You'll need about 20 filler ornaments for every 2 feet of Christmas tree. For exclusive decorating ornaments, Sally Ann alone can serve your needs. Glittery metallic stars (a pack of 4) in golden and silver colors would cost you Tk 220 to Tk 1233. Sparkling solid balls made of beads and wires are of Tk 160 each. Beside these, you can get wreaths for Tk 250, jute balls for Tk 85 and various decorating ornaments from Tk 20 to Tk 600.

Our very own local brands are not lagging behind when it comes to Christmas decorations. Folk International has a huge stock of such ornaments made of clothes, foam, paper, wood and jute. Their prices are as follows: wreaths for the front door

Tk 100 to Tk 400, balls Tk 40, Christmas bells Tk 10 to Tk 120 and decorating pieces Tk 20 to Tk 160. Aarong offers an array of ornaments including aluminum bells, glittery balls and small zari angels which would cost around Tk 40. Keeping in with the festivity Jatra has also come up with total new desi ornaments within Tk 10 to Tk 150. For Christmas lighting you can buy the night-lights for Tk 150 to 200 a stripe from most of the electrical shops.

After all that is said and done, it is the special touch that makes the difference: your home could be transformed by a single beautiful flower and foliage arrangement, or the smell of a gorgeously scented candle. So let your creativity flow and have a merry Christmas!
