

Pound hits all-time low against euro

AP, London

The British pound hit record lows against the euro on Monday for the second straight day, weighed down by falling home prices and expectations that the Bank of England will keep cutting interest rates.

The euro rose to 72.710 British pence, compared with the earlier record of 72.350 pence from May 27, 2003, according to the daily reference rate of the European Central Bank. That was the lowest since the euro began trading on financial markets in 1999.

Traders seized on data showing that house prices fell 0.3 percent in December from the month before, with the average property staying on the market for more than eight weeks, the longest since the HomeTrack survey began in 2001.

The Bank of England cut its key interest rate a quarter-point to 5.5 percent earlier this month amid fears the fallout from the U.S. subprime crisis would hurt economic growth by making it harder for companies and consumers to borrow money. Lower interest rates mean lower yields on some pound-denominated investments and can weigh on its exchange rate.

The pound also drifted lower against the dollar, to \$1.9760 from \$1.9828.

Vietnam adopts new regulation on stock investors

Beginning March 2008, stock investors in Vietnam must deposit their cash at commercial banks, instead of securities companies as currently, according to local newspaper Vietnam News on Tuesday.

The new regulation passed by Vietnam's Finance Ministry and State Securities Commission aims at ensuring that transactions are transparent and secure.

A number of banks, including Vietcombank, Asia Commercial Bank, Techcombank and Eximbank, have already offered new services for new customers, including a reduction of maintenance fees and better linkage with securities companies.

Dollar stays firm in Asia after Merrill infusion

The dollar stayed firm in Asian trade Tuesday as investors welcomed a large cash infusion into Merrill Lynch amid the subprime mortgage woes, dealers said.

The US unit stood at 114.00 yen in afternoon trade, easing slightly from 114.40 yen in New York Monday afternoon, but sharply up from 113.07 yen on Friday in Tokyo before Japanese players went into a three-day weekend.

The Tokyo market was off Monday for a national holiday.

The euro stood at 1.4391 dollars and 164.06 yen, compared with 1.4401 dollars and 164.50 yen in New York.

Investors were heartened by the announcement that Merrill Lynch had won large cash infusions of up to 6.2 billion dollars from various investors, including 4.4 billion dollars by a Singapore state-owned investment group.

Financial markets have seen turbulence for months over concerns about the US "subprime" sector, in which high-risk customers extended loans at the height of the housing boom are struggling to make mortgage payments.

The subprime trouble has raised worries about a credit crunch as financial institutions rush to cover their losses.

"With the news about Merrill, there is a sense that we are seeing

the last of all the bad news," said Mitsuru Sahara, senior vice president at Mitsubishi UFJ Bank.

"It appears that participants are willing to take more risks. We saw American brokerages being hit hard, but either they are receiving some sort of help or the impact of the damages is now ending."

He said the market was also returning "to the situation where people are again wanting to place their funds in nations with high-interest currencies."

Japan has the lowest interest rates of any major economy. Dealers looking for higher returns often place cash in high-interest rate economies such as Australia and New Zealand.

Russia to hike oil export duty by 21pc

Russia will raise duties on oil exports to around 333 dollars per tonne from February 1, a 21 percent hike, a finance ministry official was quoted as saying Tuesday.

"The tax will probably be around 332-33 dollars a tonne," said Alexander Sakovitch, cited by the Ria Novosti news agency.

The current duty is 275.4 dollars (191.1 euros) a tonne, set on December 1. Russia revises its oil export duty every two months.

Japan's DoCoMo to tie up with Google

Japan's leading mobile phone operator NTT DoCoMo Inc., trying to fight off resurgent competitors, will tie up with US search-engine giant Google Inc. to upgrade its services, a report said Tuesday.

DoCoMo will incorporate Google's search and e-mail features into its popular "i-mode" Internet service as part of a broader alliance that may lead to the development of new functions and handsets, the Nikkei business daily said.

The mobile phone giant decided on the deal as its subscribers are demanding ever-more sophisticated Internet functions on their mobile phones, said the newspaper, which did not identify its sources.

Starting as early as the spring, DoCoMo users will be able to access Google search, e-mail, scheduling and photo features through the i-mode service, the Nikkei said. Company officials did not have immediate comment.

DoCoMo, while remaining a dominant force in the domestic mobile market, has lost subscribers to rivals in the past year after a rule change allowed users to switch carriers without changing their phone numbers.

Meanwhile, Google has remained behind Yahoo Japan Corp. in the Japanese search engine market.

By teaming up with DoCoMo and gaining better access to mobile users, Google seeks to bolster its services and advertising operations in the cellular segment, the Nikkei said.

Last-minute buyers give US retailers relief

Just weeks ago, the holiday shopping season seemed headed for disaster. But in the waning hours before Christmas, the nation's retailers got their wish: a last-minute surge of shopping that helped meet their modest sales goals, according to data released late Monday by research firm ShopperTrak RCT Corp.

And with post-Christmas shopping to come, some malls and stores were downright optimistic.

While consumers jammed stores at the start of the season in search of discounts and hot items such as Nintendo Co.'s Wii game console, a challenging economy prompted them to hold out until the end for bigger discounts.

An extra full weekend before Christmas also caused shoppers to procrastinate. In fact, Christmas Eve is expected to be a bigger shopping day than in past years because many employers gave workers the day off, with the holiday falling on Tuesday.

"I'm trying to get some deals, seeing what they got out. The sales are better later on. And the stores aren't so packed right now," said Tina Fields, who was at the Circle Centre Mall in Indianapolis early on Monday morning. Her best bargain was a shirt from Aeropostale Inc. she bought for \$5. Others like Alex Allen of Boston had postponed shopping because of lack of time.

"I've been working a lot," said Allen, who took advantage of the 7 a.m. opening at a local Target Corp.

store to get toys for his three grandchildren before the largest crowds came later in the day.

The spree defied fears that a deepening housing slump, escalating credit crisis and higher gas and food prices would turn shoppers into Grinch-like even in the end. Meanwhile, with the season plagued by a slew of Chinese-made toys recalls that began in the summer, there were concerns that shoppers would boycott those products. That didn't happen either.

Still, financial concerns clearly affected how consumers behaved throughout the season, forcing more to trade down to discounters such as Wal-Mart Stores Inc., according to Fred Crawford, managing director at restructuring firm AxiPartners.
