Invitation for Re-Bids

for

Technical and Financial Proposals for Provision of Goods and Services for Street Children Living in Partnership Areas of Dhaka

1. The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a grant from the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) and allocated resources (cash and kind) to meet the cost of Protection of Children at Risk (PCAR) Project. Department of Social Services (DSS) under Ministry of Social Welfare is the Executing Agency for the Project. PCAR project started on 1st April, 2007 and is in operation upto 31 December 2008 with possibility of extension upto December 2010. Part of the PCAR budget will be applied to engage nine NGOs (four in Dhaka and rest five in remaining five divisional cities) for delivery of selected goods and services detailed in the bid document for vulnerable street children living in these cities. The selection of NGOs shall take place through an open, transparent and competitive process as detailed in the project Basic document-TPP. The contract will be for a period of nine (9) months from 1st April 2008 to 31st December 2008.

2. The project defines street children as 'Children below the age of 18 years who are living, working, playing and sleeping on the street and are deprived of basic rights' (ARISE report: A Review of Existing Services relating to street children, December 1999). Minimum age of the street children is 6 years. The project has divided street children in to four sub-categories:
 1. Children up to 18 years of age who work and live on the street without their family;
 2. Children up to 18 years of age who work and live on the street with their family;
 3. Children up to 18 years of age who work and live on the street and return to other family;
 4. Children up to 18 years of age who work and live on the street and return to their family.

3. According to Estimation of the Size of Street Children and their Projection for Major Urban Areas of Bangladesh 2005' commissioned to BIDS by ARISE, the present number of street children in six divisional cities has been estimated as 3,89,892 with a major concentration in Dhaka city (63.91%) and the lowest concentration being 2.50% of the total in Barisal.
4. The objective of the street children sub-project under the project is to sustain improvements in the living of children on street. It will help to build the capacity of the MSW and change the role of the GOB by fulfilling its commitments to implement national laws and policies for selected vulnerable children and UNCRC at all levels. The project will maintain linkage and coordination with other concerned NGOs, INGOs and government projects/organisations which are working in the fields of child welfare, protection and care. The linkages between the related stakeholders/actors and the project will help each other greatly in sharing the experiences and expertise to provide livelihood option as well social protection for the above vulnerable children.
5. The PCAR project now invites sealed bids from interested and eligible non-governmental organisations (NGOs). The selected NGO will take over from existing NGO appointed under ARISE project and shall continue to provide goods and services to the target children and to achieve improvement in coverage and quality by the end of the year 2008.
6. Each bidder/consortium including existing partner NGOs of the project may submit bids for a maximum of three (3) partnership area (package nos). The bid that results in the highest Best Responsive Bid score (technically and financially in aggregate) will be offered the opportunity to enter into the Contract with the Client. Where more than one bid receive the same Best Responsive Bid score, the one with the highest Technical Score will be awarded the Contract.

7. To qualify for awarding of the contract, bidders will need to meet the following minimum qualifying criteria:
 - (a) Evidence of having implemented projects with a total annual value equal to BDT 5,000,000 or more for each of the previous five years, by the lead agency or in aggregate in case of a joint venture;
 - (b) Evidence that the organisation has sound financial accounting practices;
 - (c) No consistent history of litigation or arbitration awards against the bidder or associated organisations;
 - (d) Minimum of five years experience working with Child Development, Child Rights/rights-based approaches and related activities, with at least five of these years by the lead agency or in aggregate in case of a joint venture;
 - (e) Registration either from Registrar of Joint Stock Company or Directorate of Social Welfare or NGO Affairs Bureau of the Government of Bangladesh, entitling bidder to work for the proposed packages/partnership area(s) and any or all of the six divisional towns;
 - (f) Have TIN and VAT registration with the National Board of Revenue;
 - (g) Have gender balance in human resource composition or maintain gender perspective. Qualified and experienced staffs in managing programmes for disadvantaged children including street children for different levels of facilities required for the work;
 - (h) Experience of working with UNICEF or in the fields of child welfare/development areas.
8. A local competitive bidding will be conducted in accordance with single stage, two-envelope bidding procedure. Bidders are to submit simultaneously two sealed envelopes, one containing the Technical Proposal(s) and the Financial Proposal(s). All proposals/bids must be submitted in English. (Paper size: A4, Margin: (1'') one inch (top, bottom, right and left) in all sides, single space, paragraph margin 6 before and after, Arial font).
9. No pre-bid meeting will be held but interested purchasers of bid documents are welcome to contact the undersigned in writing for questions and queries. All bids must be received by 2:00pm on 21 January, 2008, in the office of the National Project Director, Protection of Children at Risk (PCAR).
10. All bidders are invited to attend a public opening of the Technical Proposal envelopes at 3:00pm on 21 January 2008, in the Protection of Children at Risk (PCAR), office of the NPD, National Social Services Academy Bhaban (3rd Floor), E-8/B-1, Agargaon, Dhaka-1207, that time the names of all bidders whose proposals have been received will be recorded.
11. Bidding documents may be purchased by interested bidders upon submission of a written application to the office address given below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of 3000 (for packages Dha-3)/2000 (for packages Dha-4) (In word BDT three & two thousand respectively) for each package by cash. A copy of bid document in CD media will be provided along with the bid document. Bidders are encouraged to use the digital copy while preparing the financial proposal. In case of any discrepancy between printed and digital copy of the bid document, the printed copy shall prevail.
12. Bidding documents will be available from 10:00am to 4:30pm on all working days starting from 30 December 2007 up to 14 January 2008.
13. The client will not be responsible for any costs or expenses incurred by bidders in connection with the preparation or delivery of bids. Responsibility for timely delivery of bids rests solely with the bidders. The PCAR project will make no allowance for any delays in proposal submission.
14. All bids to accompany a bid security of three hundred thousand (for package Dha-3) and two hundred thousand (for package Dha-4) in the form of Pay Order/Bank Draft or Irrevocable Bank Guarantee from a reputed schedule bank in favour of Protection of Children at Risk (PCAR) project. The bid security Pay Order shall be included in the envelope containing the technical proposal (in original envelope).
15. Bidders should submit their bids in the prescribed place:
