The Power Grid Company of Bangladesh Limited (PGCB), the Project-Executing Agency (PEA), hereby invites qualified independent consultants to submit a prequalification document for consulting services.

Project measures:

The project will consist of,

(a) 600 MVAR shunt compensation at the 24 identified grid substations of PGCB at 33kV level and

(b) Reinforcement of PGCB's 132/33kV Goalpara substation.

Required Consultant services:

Consulting services are required for the detailed design and supervision of the implementation/construction, including:

- Review and update of the existing conceptual design of the proposed shunt compensation measures.
- Review and update/completion of the existing tender documents, including the standard terms and conditions for tenders, the estimate of quantities, the technical description of the equipment and facilities and a draft supply contract. Updating of the project costs.
- Execution of the tendering procedure, assistance in clarification of queries from prospective bidders.
- Evaluation of bids, evaluation report, award recommendation and support for the Project- Executing Agency upon conclusion of the agreement.
- Monitoring of project implementation (approx. 18 months), in terms of work progress and strict adherence to deadlines, observance of cost constraints and the quality of the supplies and services rendered, preparation of concise quarterly progress reports.
- Consulting services for the Program-Executing Agency on technical issues.
- Acceptance of the supplies and services, checking of accounts.
- Monitoring of testing and commissioning, preparation of final report.

At this stage of the procedure the guidelines for the pre-selection apply, i.e. particularly para 2.2, Annex3, and Annex4 of the KfW guidelines.

It is envisaged to award the contract to an independent Consultant experienced in the energy sector and the region with a minimum annual turnover of 5 million Euro.

Consultants must have expertise and experience in the following:

- (i) Preparation of feasibility studies for shunt compensation measures, preparation of Bidding document, drawing/design checking, supervision, testing & commissioning for reactive power compensation projects by shunt capacitor at 33kV or higher voltage level and
- (ii) Preparation of Bidding document, drawing/design checking, supervision, testing & commissioning of 110kV or above AIS Substation projects.

The Consulting services should be performed in Bangladesh over a period of about 24 months. All cost arising from obtaining information/data and preparation/ submission of pre-selection documents shall be borne by the applicants themselves.

1. This invitation for bids follows the general procurement notice for this project that appeared in development business, issue Nos. 652, dated April 16, 2005.

2. The People's Republic of Bangladesh has applied for a credit from the International Development Association (IDA) toward the cost of Health, Nutrition and Population Sector Program (HNPSP), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit to payments under the contract for procurement of 2.2 million Rubber Surgical Gloves, Size-6.5" & 1.2 million Rubber Surgical Gloves, Size-7", under contract package No. GFP-15/07.

3. The Director (Logistics and Supply) and Line Director (Procurement, Storage and Supply), Directorate General of Family Planning of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for procurement of 2.2 million Rubber Surgical Gloves, Size-6.5" & 1.2 million Rubber Surgical Gloves, Size-7" who have satisfactorily completed at least three contracts of the size of the subject procurement within the last five years. Entire goods are to be supplied within 84-98 days from the date of effectiveness of the contract agreement.

4. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD loans and IDA Credits, May 2004 and is open to all bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the guidelines.

5. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from the address mentioned below and inspect the bidding documents from 09:00am to 5:00pm in the working days.

Qualifications requirements include:

(a) Financial Capacity:

The bidder shall furnish documentary evidence that it meets the following financial requirement(s): The bidder must have an average annual turnover of at least Tk 9 million or equivalent US dollar during the last 3 years which will be supported by audited financial report prepared by any independent chartered accountant firm.

(b) Experience and Technical Capacity:

The bidder shall furnish documentary evidence to demonstrate that it meets the following experience requirement(s): (a) In the case of a bidder who manufacture the goods, the bidder should provide

- (i) documentary evidence of having annual production capacity of at least 6 million Rubber Gloves, Size-6.5" and 3 million Rubber Gloves, Size-7",
- (ii) certificate of incorporation/certificate of registration/trade licence (which one is applicable),
- (iii) a manufacturing licence for the specific goods,
- (iv) at least two (2) years experience in manufacturing and marketing of specific goods and three (3) years experience in similar goods for which the IFB is issued.

(b) If the bidder is a supplier then it should have

- (i) at least two (2) years supply experience in specific goods and three (3) years supply experience in similar goods for which the IFB is issued, (ii) the bidder should provide evidence of being duly authorized by the manufacturer, meeting the criteria under (a), (ii), (iii), (iv) above, to supply the goods in the purchasers country, as per manufacturer authorization form under Section IV, bidding forms.

(c) The bidder should have satisfactorily completed at least 3 (three) contracts of the size of the subject procurement within the last five years.

(d) The technical specification offered by the bidder should conform to the technical specification provided in the bidding documents.

A margin of domestic preference shall be applied.

7. A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by the interested bidders on the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Taka 6,500 (six thousand and five hundred) only or US\$ 100 (US dollar one hundred) only. The method of payment will be Pay-Order or Bank Draft from any schedule bank in Bangladesh or certified check from reputable foreign bank acceptable to the purchaser. The bidding documents will be sent by air mail to foreign bidders, or by courier to Bangladeshi bidders, if so requested or may be collected directly from the address below.

8. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before 11:00am of Bangladesh Standard Time (BST) on 15 February, 2007. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected and shall be returned unopened. Bids will be opened in presence of the bidder representatives who choose to attend in person at the address below at 12:15pm BST on 15 February, 2007. The bids must be accompanied by a bid security of Bangladesh Tk 5,00,000 or US\$ 7,000 or equivalent amount in freely convertible currency.

9. A pre-bid conference will be held on 21 January, 2007 in the office room of undersigned at 11:30am BST. All prospective bidders/bidders' representatives are requested to attend the conference in time.
