

Tremor shakes Rangamati

UNB, Dhaka

A mild tremor shook Rangamati hill district and its adjoining areas in Chittagong early yesterday.

The earthquake, measuring 4.8 on the Richter scale, occurred at 4:44am, says a Met office release.

The epicentre of the tremor was 226kms southeast from Agargaon Seismic Centre in Dhaka.

Local people came out of their houses "out of panic" when the quake started jolting the areas. Cracks developed in a number of buildings in the town.

BLDG CONSTRUCTION (AMEND) ORDN Place draft after further changes

Council of Advisers asks ministry

UNB, Dhaka

The Council of Advisers yesterday discussed elaborately the draft Building Construction (Amendment) Ordinance 2008 and asked the ministry concerned to place it after further changes.

Housing and Public Works Ministry placed the draft Building Construction Ordinance for amending the Building Construction Act 1952, aiming to make the house-construction rules fit in the present times.

A regular meeting of the Council of Advisers chaired by Chief Adviser Fakhruddin Ahmed also asked the ministry to revise the key Building Construction Act 1952 for bringing

necessary changes to the draft of the new law.

It also suggested giving the matter into "public domain for debate and public input" before making the act.

The meeting also discussed the draft National Women Development Policy 2008 amending the National Women Development Policy 2004, and asked the ministry concerned to do further vetting and place it again before the council.

All members of the council of advisers attended the meeting at the CA's office. The newly appointed three special assistants to chief adviser also attended the meeting on special invitation.

Call for proper evaluation of Tajuddin's leadership

Speakers at a discussion have called for proper evaluation of the leadership of Tajuddin Ahmed, the first prime minister of Bangladesh, during the liberation war.
