



A UNIQUE GARDEN AT BDR HEADQUARTERS

DAZZLING colours of rare flowers, trimly cut tufts of grass and green patches of trees adorn the unique garden inside the BDR headquarters at Pilkhana. Many of us do not know this 'hidden paradise'. The garden contains around 220 species of roses meticulously reared by the BDR personnel.
