#### Hasina should be freed immediately Zillur says

UNB, Dhaka

Awami League (AL) Acting President Zillur Rahman yesterday said our party chief should be released immediately after the confession of Azam J Chowdhury that he had not filed any extortion case against Sheikh Hasina.
