

Pfister can't stop smoking

Cameroon coach Otto Pfister came under fire here Thursday for setting a bad example by smoking at the Baba Yara Stadium in Kumasi during Saturday's game against Zambia.

The condemnation of the 70-year-old's decision to light up in a stadium where smoking is banned came from the Abimbimman Foundation, a local non-government health organisation.

The body issued a statement accusing the oldest manager at the African Nations Cup of giving a bad image to young people in Ghana and Africa at large, the Ghanaian Times reported.

"This negative behaviour must not be allowed to continue in Ghana," the statement insisted.

"We are therefore calling on the Local Organising committee to draw the attention of coach Otto Pfister to his actions."

It recalled that Pfister is a well known figure on the continental football stage, and carries serious influence with the youth of the country.

The silver-haired veteran's impact is such that according to The Times his penchant for wearing trousers and shorts far below the waist started a new style trend known as the 'Otto Pfister'.

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ITALIAN CUP Teenagers prove match-winners

Teenage strikers Takayuki Morimoto and Mario Balotelli proved the match-winners to send Catania and Inter Milan respectively into the Italian Cup semifinals on Wednesday.

Japanese 19-year-old Morimoto came off the bench to make history for Catania by sending them into the last four for the first time after a 2-1 win over Udinese, putting the Sicilians through on away goals after a 4-4 aggregate draw.

And Balotelli, two years Morimoto's junior, scored a brace, including the decisive goal, as the champions and league leaders won 3-2 at Juventus to secure a 5-4 aggregate victory.

Beaten Juve coach Claudio Ranieri admitted his rivals have unearthed a gem in Balotelli.

"I had already seen him play against our youth team and I liked what I saw," he said. "He knows where the goal is and his movements are excellent."

What was even more impressive with Inter's victory is that top scorer and Sweden forward Zlatan Ibrahimovic and first-choice

Brazilian goalkeeper Doni were left at home while France captain Patrick Vieira, Argentine club captain Javier Zanetti, his countryman Esteban Cambiasso and Romania centre-back Cristian Chivu all started on the bench.

But such is Inter's strength in depth that the powerful Balotelli made the difference, scoring his third and fourth goals in three Cup appearances this season.

He opened the scoring on 10 minutes, only for Italy veteran Alessandro Del Piero to hit back four minutes later for the hosts with a free-kick.

Del Piero's strike-partner Vincenzo Iaquinta gave Juve the lead just past the half-hour mark but Argentine forward Julio Cruz levelled from the spot following a handball six minutes from the break.

On 54 minutes, Balotelli thrashed home the winner after holding off his marker.

Juve sent on French forward David Trezeguet for the last quarter-hour but veteran Italian goalkeeper Francesco Toldo made a brilliant one-handed save to deny him.

Any chance Juve had of turning the match around disappeared five minutes from time when Mauro Camoranesi, making his return from injury off the bench, was

No loan move for Walcott

Arsenal teenager Theo Walcott has ruled out a move to another club on loan in order to fast-track his development.

Two years after becoming the most expensive 16-year-old in football history, Walcott is still struggling to secure first-team opportunities at the Emirates.

Gunners boss Arsene Wenger recently admitted that the forward had not developed as quickly as he had anticipated when he agreed to pay Southampton up to 12 million pounds to sign him.

Those remarks triggered enquiries from teams keen on taking Walcott out on loan and there had been suggestions that he could benefit from playing regularly.

But the 18-year-old believes he can develop just as quickly by staying where he is.

"Every day I play at Arsenal, I train with some of the best players in the world," he said.

"My game is obviously going to benefit most from being around these people. With respect to other clubs, that is not going to happen anywhere else."

Valencia lift gloom

Troubled Valencia lifted the gloom on Wednesday when they claimed a place in the semifinals of the King's Cup after an away goals win over Atletico Madrid.

Valencia, who have won just one of their last 10 league matches, lost 3-2 on the night, but their 1-0 win in the first leg was enough to see them through to the last four.

Trailing 1-0 after the first leg, the islanders looked to be on course for victory after an Ariel Ibagaza penalty and a close-range header from Venezuelan striker Juan Arango put them 2-0 up.

But midfielder Esteban Granero stunned the home crowd when his curling cross bounced between a forest of players and crept in at the far post nine minutes from time.

Granero was red-carded a minute from time but the sending off did little to dampen his team's celebrations.

The game at the Calderon started badly for Valencia, fullback Miguel Bando hitting his own net in the 10th minute after Diego Forlan curled a cross into the area.

Atletico went 2-0 up nine minutes later, Argentine striker Sergio Agüero cracking a low shot in off the far post after a sharp through-ball from Forlan.

But the tie was turned on its head when Atletico midfielder Cleber Santana sent the ball into his own net after Valencia striker Villa tried to cut past him on the edge of the area.

Valencia extended their advantage before the break when forward Juan Manuel Mata hammered home inside the near post from the left side of the area.

Atletico piled forward into attack and went 3-2 up on the hour when defender Juan Valera headed in after a corner. But their efforts were to avail as Valencia kept them at bay for the rest of the game.

Barcelona host Villarreal at the Nou Camp on Thursday, while Racing Santander travel to Athletic Bilbao.

In Sicily Simone Pepe got Udinese off to a dream start, prod-ding home at the back post from barely a yard out.

Lazio are also through to the semis to meet Inter after completing a 4-2 aggregate victory over Fiorentina following a 2-1 victory in Florence on Wednesday.

The hosts took the lead on 17 minutes through Franco Semioli but Russian defender Aleksandar Kolarov levelled for the Romans 10 minutes before the break.

And the visitors sealed their passage into the last four when forward Tommaso Rocchi snatched the winner just past the hour mark.

Bayern lay down law

Bayern Munich will re-launch their Bundesliga bid at Hansa Rostock on Friday with discipline of paramount importance having issued their players with a strict code of conduct.

After captain Oliver Kahn was banned for Bayern's last Bundesliga game of the year at Hertha Berlin in December before their six-week Christmas break for criticising his teammates, coach Ottmar Hitzfeld has laid down the law.

With his side having squandered the six-point lead they held in October to currently share the league lead with rivals Werder Bremen, Hitzfeld has toughened up on discipline as his side re-launch their bid for silverware.

"It is a question of giving direction and an orientation to the players in regards to their conduct towards teammates, supporters, the press and the public," Hitzfeld told the Bayern website.

"It is to help the foreign players who do not know us well yet and don't know the philosophy of the club," added Hitzfeld who will be replaced by Jurgen Klinsmann as head coach next season.

Just two league wins in their last six games, including a 3-1 hammering at defending champions VfB Stuttgart, are not the sort of

results Hitzfeld expects from a squad costing 69 million euros (100 million US dollars).

Even with striker Lukas Podolski again succumbing to injury with a slipped disc, Bayern have in-form forwards Miroslav Klose and Luca Toni to rely on, both of whom scored in Bayern's 5-2 German Cup hammering of minnows Wuppertal last Tuesday, and should be too strong for Hansa.

Strugglers Rostock, who linger just above the relegation zone, were hammered 3-0 at the Allianz Arena on the opening weekend of the season in August and a similar result in Rostock would keep Bayern's fans happy.

On Saturday, third-placed Hamburg host fifth-placed Hannover with a question mark still hanging over their want-away captain Rafael van der Vaart who seems set to leave the club this summer having expressed his desire to play in Spain.

Having signed towering Czech

striker Jan Koller during the winter break, Nuremberg will be looking to dig themselves out of the deep hole they face having dropped into the relegation zone before Christmas.

They are at six-placed Karlsruhe, one of the surprise packages of the Bundesliga this season and Nuremberg need to start improving before their UEFA Cup clash with Benfica next month.

Having dumped Bremen out of the German Cup in midweek, Borussia Dortmund coach Thomas Doll, who extended his contract earlier this month, will take his mid-table side to bottom side Duisburg.

And having recovered from a poor start to the season, Stuttgart have lifted themselves to eighth in the table, with striker Mario Gomez hitting a hat-trick in midweek.

They will be looking to lower Schalke's colours, Germany's only remaining team in the Champions League, when they meet on Sunday.

The Royal Blues have only lost once in the last ten league games, but were knocked out of the German Cup in midweek, and are hoping German striker Kevin Kuranyi will have shaken off the ill-effects of pneumonia.

In Sunday's other game Werder Bremen - Bayern's main challengers at the top of the table - have few other distractions having been knocked out of the Champions League and the German Cup as they host struggling Bochum.

Defender Gilberto will not be joining English Premier League side Tottenham Hotspur from Bundesliga side Hertha Berlin, after the Brazilian failed a medical and is expected back in Berlin on Thursday.

Both clubs had agreed a transfer for the 31-year-old, but Sunday's medical examination highlighted some undisclosed problems and the deal fell through meaning the 27-time capped Brazilian will honour his Berlin contract which expires this summer.

According to reports in the German press, Spurs had been willing to pay 2.6 million euros (3.8 million US dollars) for Gilberto, who can play in midfield or defence.

Gomez nets hat-trick

Germany's player of 2007, Mario Gomez, announced his return to form with a hat-trick in just 14 minutes to book VfB Stuttgart's place in the German Cup quarterfinals.

The 22-year-old has been out of action since injuring ribs at the end of November, but he struck three first-half goals Wednesday at Stuttgart beat Werder Bremen's reserves 3-2 to reach the German Cup's quarterfinals.

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Having led 3-0 at the break, Werder's reserves fought back, but Stuttgart were always in control.

In Wednesday's all-Bundesliga clash, Schalke 04 went down 5-3 on penalties to VfL Wolfsburg after the Royal Blues conceded a goal in the

91st minute and the hosts fought hard to book their place in the last eight.

Bundesliga title contenders Hamburg made light work of their third division opponents Rot-Weiss Essen as captain Rafael van der Vaart opened the scoring in a 3-0 win.

Bundesliga side Arminia Bielefeld suffered an upset in extra time when second division Carl Zeiss Jena's Czech midfielder, Jan Simak, slotted home a penalty in the 116th minute to put his side in the last eight.

On Tuesday league leaders Bayern Munich booked their quarterfinal berth with a convincing 5-2 win at third division minnows Wuppertal.

Germany striker Miroslav Klose netted twice in the first half for Bayern, but the hosts gave the

Belgian defender Daniel van Buyten, Italian World Cup winner Luca Toni and Turkish midfielder Hamit Altintop bagged second-half goals to put the result beyond doubt.

Bayern's league rivals Werder Bremen crashed out of the competition when they were beaten 2-1 at Borussia Dortmund.

Second-division 1860 Munich enjoyed a stunning fightback when they scored three goals in just six minutes as they turned a 2-0 deficit into a 3-2 win at Alemannia Aachen and sealed the win two minutes from time.

Second division Hoffenheim claimed the scalp of Bundesliga strugglers Hansa Rostock with a comfortable 2-1 win.
