Nirjatan Protirodh Chhatra Andolon, a students' platform led by the Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), vesterday urged the government to reduce the amount of quota in the BCS examinations to a reasonable level.

The quotas for the freedom fighters' children, indigenous people and women are not fulfilled most of the time, the student leaders said at a press conference on the Dhaka University campus.

In the Bangladesh Public Service Commission's (PSC) BCS examinations, 55 percent of appointments is made under four quotas -- 30 percent PSC.

reserved under freedom fighters' children quota, 10 percent under women's quota, 10 percent under district quota and five percent under indigenous quota.

Only six to eight percent of freedom fighters' quota and one percent of indigenous quota is filled up, the leaders said.

They called on the students to refrain from demanding total cancellation of the quota system.

Meanwhile, several left- 5 leaning student organisations staged a demonstration on the campus under the banner of 'Students of Dhaka University and demanded reforms in the
