

MINOR BOY KIDNAP CASE IN SATKHIRA

Court rejects 2nd charge sheet, orders judicial probe

The Women and Children Repression Preventive Court here rejected CID charge sheet in seven year-old Victor kidnap case and ordered a judicial probe into the case.

This was the second time that court rejected charge sheet submitted by police and CID on grounds of improper investigation.

Judge Motazidur Rahman also asked a judicial magistrate to probe the case, court sources said.

Victor Haldar, 7, son of Dinabandhu Haldar of Dhankhalirchak village in Shyamnagar upazila was kidnapped by some miscreants from near his house on May

22, 2005. He is missing since then.

The miscreants sent four letters to the victim's father demanding Tk 5 lakh ransom for his release.

On May 29, the victim's father filed a case with Shyamnagar police station.

Later, local people detected Basu Dev Haldar of the same village to be sender of the letters. They caught and handed him over to Shyamnagar police.

But police released him and were allegedly trying to divert the case and destroy its merit, sources claimed earlier.

The then Shyamnagar thana officer-in-charge and two sub-inspectors were suspended in this regard.

Sub-inspector Swapan Kumar

Saha had submitted charge sheet to a court against Basu Dev Haldar on September 30, 2005.

As the complainant submitted a 'naraji' petition, the court asked CID for further investigation.

The CID investigation officer (IO) arrested Victor's uncle Krishna Pada Haldar and submitted a fresh charge sheet accusing him and two others—Basudev and local Union Parishad member Abu Bakkar.

Yesterday, during hearing, the complainant again submitted a 'naraji' petition, alleging that CID did not investigate the case properly.

The court accepted the naraji petition and ordered a judicial probe into the case, court sources said.

Most criminals act within knowledge of police, says IGP

Most criminals commit crimes within the knowledge of police or have links with them, Inspector General of Police (IGP) Nur Mohammad said yesterday.

He was speaking at a ceremony marking laying foundation of Katiadi model police station.

IGP Nur Mohammad said, an instinctive fear about police prevails in the mind of people and it takes time to create such a fear. Police have to take the responsibility to remove the fear and earn people's confidence.

For this, police should behave as friend of people not of criminals, the IGP said.

Katiadi is the native upazila of Nur Mohammad. He also told the gathering at the ceremony that some local people told him about availability of drugs in the upazila but police denied it.

"Of course police know the drug traders and peddlers and they have to stop the heinous act".

Katiadi model police station is being set up on 1.5 acres of land at a cost of Tk 6 crore under a police

6 of fake NGO sent to jail for swindling Tk 6cr

Six persons of a fake NGO, caught for cheating people in the name of giving autorickshaws at lower price, were sent to jail here yesterday.

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) caught them Tuesday night from Ganganagar area in South Surma upazila and handed over them to police. They were produced before a court, which sent them to jail.

The arrestees are, chairperson of Agragami Bahumukhi Nari Unnayan Sangstha Syeda Luthfunnahar of Bahadurpur, Beanibazar, Sylhet; its managing director Md Kamal Uddin of Chhoti Madarkhali of Barguna; manager Mrinal Kanti Roy of Dariakul village in Tungipara of Gopalganj and advisors Ali Akhsan Rubin of Kushighat, Dakshin Surma, Sylhet; Md. Abu Sayeed of Ganganagar, Sylhet and

Kabir Ahmed of Chowkidahi, Sylhet city.

Police said, the arrestees and other officials of the organisation realised over Tk 6 crore from people in the name of giving 4-stroke

autorickshaws at Tk one lakh each. But none got it even several years after payment.

They also collected money in the name of DPS (deposit pension scheme), double amounts

after a year.

The so-called organisation opened a well decorated office at a house at Ganganagar area in the city and began their work years ago, police said.

Kushtia college students lock offices for regular classes

Students of Khater Ali Intermediate College here yesterday locked the college offices demanding regular classes and examinations in their college.

They also demanded immediate appointment of a principal as the college is now being run by an 'inefficient' acting principal who does not pay heed to their demands despite repeated appeals.

There are 300 students and 77 teachers in the college. But students alleged most of the teachers do not attend their classes regularly. They allegedly come to the college to sign on their register and take salaries in the first week of every month.

They announced a fresh programme today to meet their demands which included a sit-in programme on Kushtia-Khulna highway.

When contacted, Kushtia Sadar upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Mahbubur Rahman, also president of the college said the situation is still in control. He is trying to solve problems of the college by holding meeting with all the teachers of the college.

RU PROF YUNUS MURDER
Trial to resume Mar 9
in dist judge's court

Trial of Rajshahi University (RU) teacher Prof Muhammad Yunus murder case will now begin on March 9.

Eight militants of Jama'atul Mujahidin, Bangladesh (JMB) are accused in the case.

Rajshahi Chief Metropolitan Magistrate court yesterday shifted the case documents to District and Sessions Judge's court after preparing those for trial.

CID (Criminal Investigation Department) Inspector Mohammad Helaudin pressed charges against the eight militants on September 10 last year and relieved 13 other accused including some activists of Islami Chhatra Shibir from charges.

Earlier, police reports said involvement of Shibir activists but the investigation took a new turn following confessional statement of JMB chief Shayakh Abdur Rahman.

The accused persons are zonal JMB commanders -- Abu Isa Enamul and Golamur Rahman Mostafa, an adherent of Galib's Ahle Hadith Jubo Shanga, and militants -- Abul Kashem Tufan, Abdul Matin Bomaru, Abdur Rahman Arif and Zakir Zayed.

Prof. Yunus, a teacher of economics and former RU registrar, was killed during morning walk near his Binodhpur house on December 24, 2004.

Satkhira poura commissioner gets 5 yr RI

A court here yesterday sentenced a commissioner of Satkhira pourasava to five years' rigorous imprisonment for keeping drug.

The court also fined convicted Mujibullah Ailu Tk 2000, in default two serve RI for two months more, court sources said. He is son of Khaibar Rahman Sardar of Pransayer area in the town.

Judge Samsul Arefin of Additional District and Session's Judge's court delivered the verdict. The case against Mujibullah was filed with Satkhira Sadar police station on December 14, in 2002 after he was caught with Indian drugs in Barkekhali area in the Sadar upazila.

5 AUG 17 SERIAL BLAST CASES IN SATKHIRA

Deposition of 19 PWs recorded so far

Five more prosecution witnesses (PWs) of five August 17 serial blast cases gave statements before a court here amid tight security yesterday, court sources said.

With them, the court recorded statements of a total of 19 PWs.

Judge Mahbubul Alam of Additional Sessions Judge's Court recorded the statements.

The witnesses are Ruhul Amin, Rezaul Islam, Safiqul Islam, Shahidul Islam and Mofazzel Hossain. The next date of hearing was fixed on March 17.

Earlier, statements of 14 other witnesses were recorded on February 14, 17, 18 and 26. They are

first class magistrate Saidur Rahman, Rokonzaman, Abdul Gaffar, Mizanur Rahman, sub-inspector (SI) AK Nazibul Islam, SI Abu Taher, Habibur Rahman SI Safiqul Islam, SI Jasim Uddin, SI Hazrat Ali, Shahidul Islam, Rejaul Islam, Mofazzel Hossain and Rawshan Ali, a pickpocket and lone eyewitness of the case.

Eleven out of 19 charge sheeted accused were present during recording of statement yesterday.

Five other accused—Montaz alias Montaz, Abul Khair, Fakar Uddin, Nayeem and Syed alias Asaduzzaman—are absconding.

Police filed the five cases with Sadar police station soon after blasts on August 17, 2005.
