EXTORTION CASE AGAINST 4 SATKHIRA EX-MPS, 3 COPS

No progress in probe in eight months

There is virtually no progress in investigation of the extortion case against three former Jamaat-e-Islami lawmakers, a former BJP lawmaker and seven others, eight months after its filing.

The accused former lawmakers are Maulana Abdul Khaleque, Maulana Riasat Ali and Gazi Nazrul Islam of Jamaat and Kazi Ala Uddin of BJP (Naziur).

The seven others are retired assistant police superintendents Mostafa Abdul Halim and Akhtaruzzaman of Criminal Investigation Department (CID), sub-inspector (SI) Ruhul Amin Mollah of Satkhira detective branch (DB), Sheikh Abdul Khaleque, Azadul Islam Mollah and Safigul Islam Milon.

Sonadanga police station in Khulna city recorded he case on December 31 last year, five months after its filing with the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's court there on July 8 last year.

Jamaat leaders Abdul Khaleque, Riasat Ali and Gazi Nazrul Islam were elected from Satkhira-2 (Sadar), Satkhira-3 (Assassuni) and Satkhira-5 (Shyamnagar) constituencies respectively and Kazi Ala Uddin was elected from Satkhira- 4 (Kaligonj-Debhata) in 2001 election as BNP led 4- party alliance candidates.

Gazi Nazrul Islam is now in jail. Abdus Sattar Moral, a resident of 8, Sher-e-Bangla road in Khulna, filed the extortion case with Khulna Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's court on July 8 last year.

In the case, the plaintiff alleged that all the accused in collaboration with each other implicated

The ASP informed him that the then state minister for home Nuruzzaman Babar and ministerin-charge for Satkhira Aman Ullah

Aman were interested in the case. "ASP Akhtaruzzaman as toll on May 15 last year. demanded Tk 5 lakh and I gave him Tk 30,000", Abdus Sattar said in the

complaint. Later, ASP Akhtaruzzaman was transferred and ASP Mostafa Abdul

Halim was made the IO, he said. Abdus Sattar alleged he also gave Tk 17,000 to ASP Akhtaruzzaman on October 17, 2006.

After hearing, Khulna Chief Metropolitan Magistrate Zamal Uddin Ahmed on July 8 last year asked the officer-in-charge of Sonadanga police station to investigate the case and take action but police did not record the case.

After separation of the judiciary on November 1 last year, police recorded the case on December 31 on orders from Metropolitan Judicial Magistrate Mahbubur Rahman.

Contacted over cell phone, all the four former lawmakers

refuted the allegation and said the extortion case is false, filed to defame them and spoil their political career. Sonadanga thana OC

Shahidul Islam in Khulna city, when contacted, however said the case is now under investigation and action will be taken against the accused if they are found guilty.

They are getting interest in wheat cultivation due to its increasing demand, high price, favorable weather and its lower production cost than IRRI-Boro

The farmers have cultivated 47,800 hectares of land against the production target of 97,150 tonnes in the market. in the district, Department of Agriculture Extension (DAE) officials said.

wheat is easy and production cost less than that of IRRI-Boro paddy, they said, adding that the production target will be exceeded if the favourable weather contin-

Gangni Poura chairman suspended



WIFE 'MURDER'

OC Mizanur suspended, victim's body exhumed

Patkelghata Police Station officer in charge (OC) Kazi Mizanur Rahman who allegedly beat up his wife Sadia Akhtar that led to her death on Thursday, was suspended yesterday following record of the case with the same police station.

The accused police offreer has remained absconding after burial of the victim's body at Shahjahanpur graveyard in Dhaka on March 7, sources said.

The body was exhumed yesterday in presence of Magistrate Kamrunnessa and the post mortem will be done today, Satkhira Superintendent of Police Mirza Abdullahel Baki said.

Earlier on Saturday, the victim

Sadia Sultana's mother Tayebunnesa Khatun, who is now residing in Dhaka, submitted an FIR (first information report) to Motijheel Police Station in Dhaka as she was unable to go to Satkhira due her ailments, Satkhira police said.

Motijheel police sent the FIR to Patkelghata Police Station that recorded the case against OC Kazi Mizanur Rahman immediately after getting the FIR at about 10:30am yesterday, sources said.

Sadia went to her husband Kazi Mizanur Rahman's quarter at Patkelghata Police Station on February 25 and Mizanur beat her mercilessly, leaving her seriously injured on February 27, the complainant said in the FIR.

Khagrachhari BNP leader sent to jail

Organising secretary of Khagrachhari district BNP Mostafizur Rahman Millat was sent to jail yesterday when he surrendered to the court of Chief Judicial Magistrate here.

Sources at Khagrachhari Sadar police station said Millat, a wanted criminal, appeared before the court of Judicial Magistrate Abul Bashar Munshi at about 11 am. The judge rejected his bail

prayer and sent to jail. Millat faces allegations of tender manipulation, murder and anti-social activities, done during five years' BNP rule.

But neither the district administration nor police took any action against him. Though cases were filed against

him, investigation officers dropped his name, many victims claimed.

Millat was allegedly involved in the murder of local Awami Leauge leader Nurul Islam. He was killed on November 9, 2006.

When asked, ASP Tareq Ahmed said Millat was on their arrest list. Police raided his house several times to nab him but he was absconding since the arrest of district BNP chief Wadud Bhiuyan on February 4 last year.
