Boeing 747-200 to land at ZIA today

The Boeing 747-200, which the Biman Bangladesh Airlines has taken lease from a Nigeria-based airline, will land at Zia International Airport at around 9:00am today, Biman officials said.

"The leased 542-seater Boeing aircraft will fly towards Dhaka from Nigeria at 6:00pm (Nigerian local time) and is likely to arrive here in ZIA at around 9:00am (Bangladesh local time) today," a Biman official told The Daily Star last night.

"We got the last overfly permission from Indian Civil Aviation Authority last night," added the Biman official.

Biman has leased a Boeing 747-200 from Nigeria-based Kabo Air Ltd in a bid to minimise the disruptions in flight schedules.

Under the Aircraft, Crew, Maintenance and Insurance (ACMI) lease process, the Kabo Air will provide all staffs and crew of the wide-body aircraft while Biman will supply fuel.

The leased aircraft will serve Biman for at least six months and its lease might be extended after that, following a negotiation between the two sides.

"Under the lease condition, Biman will have to pay Kabo Air Ltd \$5,300 per every block hour (every flying hour from take-off to landing)," a Biman official said.

Earlier on July 2007, Biman Bangladesh Airlines Ltd purchased an Airbus A-310 from US-based Crane International for \$12.4 million.

Security Service Group won't take licence from DMP

Several Dhaka-based private security service providers yesterday said they would not take licence from Dhaka Metropolitan Police (DMP).

National Press Club, the Dhaka Divisional Security Service Owners' Group also said they would not pay the security deposit, registration fee and renewal charges.

Group leaders Mohammad Rafiqul Islam Mollah and Maj (retd) Akhteruzzaman, also a former lawmaker, were present at the press conference.

The government recently asked all the private security companies to have licences. The companies in the capital should take licence from the DMP Commissioner's office while the district-level companies from the offices of deputy commissioners.

The last date of taking licence was March 5, which has now been extended up to March 31.

At the press conference, the Security Services Owners' Group alleged that the DMP commissioner had misused his power by issuing the order to take licences from the DMP. Maj (retd) Akhteruzzaman' also

Distribute NIC, voter ID cards immediately'

Former chief election commissioner (CEC) Justice M Abdur Rouf yesterday said that national identity and voter identity cards should be distributed immediately so that people don't need to worry about the national election anymore.

"Many people are now anxious over the national election. The present caretaker government and election commission (EC) will have to take effective measures for eliminating the anxiety. For this reason, national identity and voter identity cards will have to be distributed immediately," Justice Abdur Rouf said while addressing a roundtable.

Bangladesh Sachetan Nagarik Samaj, (conscious citizens' group), organised the roundtable on 'National Election: Citizens' Views' at the National Press Club in the city where speakers urged the EC to declare the election schedule.
