Define executive role of local govt commission


Speakers tell roundtable

Renowned academic Prof Muzaffer Ahmad said the commission would have less power than the local government ministry if the draft ordinance is implemented.

ISD President Hasanul Haq Inu said the draft ordinance is vague and unacceptable.

Balakrishnan Menon of the World Bank said the proposed ordinance should make it clear how the commission would be financed.
