14	Background	The Government of Bangladesh (GOB) has undertaken to implement the Avian Influenza Preparedness and Response Project (AIPRP) to minimize the threat posed by Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) to humans in Bangladesh. The Department of Livestock Services has been designated to implement the Project with funds from IDA and AHITF through World Bank. A Project Coordination Unit (PCU) has been established to run the project. The PCU will be responsible for project implementation, coordination, communication, procurement and financial management. To implement the project, goods, works and services will be procured by PCU. Materials to be procured are laboratory machineries, diagnostic reagent, computer hardware & software (including network interface), photocopy, air conditioners, office vehicles, furniture & fixture, renovation and repairs of laboratories, and consultancy services, both local and international, following World Bank Guidelines and PPR, 2003. Total procurement under the Project will involve goods of US\$10.75 million, followed by consultancy services of US\$2.38; training, studies and workshops of US\$2.45 million; and civil works of US\$0.72 million.
