## 4 killed in road accidents

### STAR REPORT

At least four people were killed and 45 others injured in separate road accidents in Khulna, Keraniganj, Habiganj and Jhenidah yesterday and on Sunday.

Staff correspondent from Khulna reports: One person was killed and 40 others were injured, eight of them severely, in a road accident at Shibpur under Kachua upazila in Bagerhat.

The dead was identified as Russel Howlader, 10, son of Abdul Latif Howlader of Sharupkati upazila in Projpur district.

Of the injured, 25 were rushed to Kachua Hospital and Bagerhat General Hospital while 15 others were given first aid.

Witnesses and police said the accident occurred when Khulna-bound passenger bus from Barisal skidded off the road and fell into a ditch as its driver lost his control over the steering due to rush driving.

The bus is still lying upturned in the place of occurrence, police said.

Condition of eight is critical with severe injuries in head, chest and eyes, police said.

UNB from Keraniganj reports: A CNG-run auto-rickshaw driver was killed and two passengers were injured in a road accident on Dhaka-Maowa highway at Rajendrapur in South Keraniganj yesterday.

Police said a passenger bus of Nagar Paribahan hit the auto-rickshaw, killing its driver on the spot and injuring two passengers.

The dead was identified as Helal, 22, while the injured could not be known immediately.

The injured were admitted to Mitford Hospital in critical condition.

Meanwhile: Two people, including a schoolboy, were killed and three others injured in separate road accidents in Jhenidah and Habiganj on Sunday and Monday.

In Habiganj, a schoolboy was crushed under the wheels of a bus on Laghai-Habiganj road at Lakura in Sadar upazila yesterday.

Local sources said a passenger bus ran over Nayan Mia, 13, son of Abdur Rahman of Richi village in the upazila, at about 7:45am while he was crossing the road, killing him on the spot.

Angered by the accident, local people damaged a number of vehicles and barricaded the road for around two hours.

Police rushed to the spot and brought the situation under control.

In Jhenidah, a man was killed and three others were injured when a bus hit a human hauler, popularly known as Nasiman, on Jhenidah-Kushtia in the Garagang bus stand area in Shailakupa upazila road on Sunday.

Witnesses said a speeding bus, carrying students of Islamic University, hit the Nasiman at about 1:15pm, killing the three-wheeler's driver Sirajul Islam, 35, on the spot and injuring three others.

Two injured were rushed to Kushtia General Hospital in critical condition.

## Three injured in bomb blast

Three people were injured in a bomb explosion at Phultala yesterday.

The injured -- Naurin Sultana, 28, her son Tasim, 8, and Afroza Kabir, 35, -- were admitted to Phultala hospital with severe injuries.

Tasim picked up the abandoned bomb from a heap of sand in front of his house at Phultala Bazar at around 12:15pm. The bomb went off when he hurled it, sources said.

The police said somebody had kept the bomb there with an ulterior motive.
