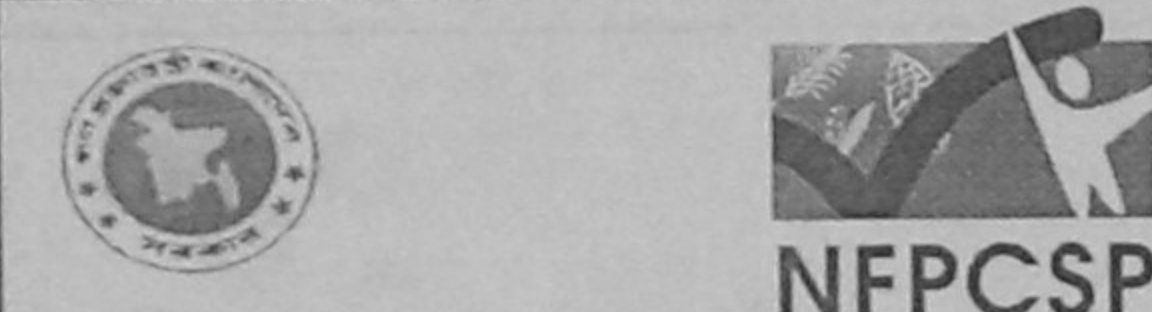

CALL FOR RESEARCH PROPOSALS UNDER THE CHALLENGE FUND (CF)

The Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the United Nations and the Food Planning and Monitoring Unit (FPMU) of the Ministry of Food and Disaster Management, Government of Bangladesh are implementing the NFPCSP with financial support from European Commission (EC) and United States Agency for International Development (USAID). The objective of the NFPCSP Research Grant Initiative is to assist in improving research and dialogue in civil society to inform and enrich the implementation of the National Food Policy.

The NFPCSP invites research proposals with a clear socio economic focus to be considered for funding under the Challenge Fund. The research proposal(s) must address a topic that falls under one or more of the following research themes:

Grants will be awarded to the best research proposals specified within the above themes, including proposals that seek to describe, analyze and formulate options for scaling up experiences from interventions or practices of the Government or Civil Society Organizations (CSO). Grants will range from US\$ 2,000 to US\$ 10,000 (in BDT equivalent) per approved research proposal and will have to be completed within 12 months from the date of award. Interested non-profit institutions and individuals through institutions of affiliation can submit research proposal(s) following the Guidelines for Submission, Selection and Implementation of Research Proposals (reference: NFPCSP/RGS/Guidelines/2007/01) which can be downloaded from the website www.nfpcsp.org or obtained together with the RND sending an e-mail to rgi@nfpcsp.org writing rgi@nfpcsp.org in the subject.
