Agriculture Adviser CS Karim yesterday expressed concern over the increasing price of fertiliser in the global market, saying that the price hike may result in the non-availability of the agricultural input.

"The fertiliser price is increasing on the global market, which may shrink the supply of the adviser said. the agricultural input in the days to come," CS karim said.

The adviser made the remark at a roundtable on 'food security and budget from the perspective of the marginalized people', organized jointly by Sammunnay and Manusher Jonno, at the National Press Club in Dhaka.

The Sammunnay chairman also suggested for duty free import of LCC and other agriculture equipment.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Finland recently sent a letter to the Bangladesh government seeking removal of tariff and non-tariff barriers for boosting bilateral trade between the two countries.

Meanwhile, Bangladesh Bangladesh. Tariff Commission (BTC) on Sunday sat with businessmen and government officials to discuss ways and means to remove trade barriers Finland.
