as British High Commissioner, is that the relationship has not stood still - its boundaries continue to grow; new vistas for co-operation emerge.

Climate Change

The recent high-profile Bangladesh-UK climate change conference in Dhaka, (organised by the High Commission and DFID in collaboration with the Bangladeshi Government) is

an excellent example of this. We want the same things. The UK sees the compelling case for action in Bangladesh, the urgency of adapting to the impacts of climate change. We are helping through substantial DFID programmes and helping Bangladesh to shape a mechanism for receiving even more funding for adaptation. We know Bangladesh will not surrender to a 'victim mentality'; it is a pioneer in adaptation and can be influential on the world stage. The UK will continue to shine a light on one of the countries most at risk from climate change impacts, to help galvanise global consensus on cutting carbon emissions. Supporting Bangladesh's example, its people and its leadership can be decisive in tipping the balance. We will take this forward at the forthcoming top-level international climate change conference on Bangladesh, to be held in London.

Taking on terrorism and extremism together

Britain and Bangladesh, sadly, have both known the horrors of indiscriminate terrorist violence. We will continue to work together with Bangladesh to counter the threat of those who seek to profit from division, suspicion and violence. Our Home Secretary and your Home Adviser announced the formation of a Joint Working Group to take this on. And our new level of co-operation will go further - to address the root causes of extremism both here and around the world, and to express the solidarity of our peoples and articulate their common values of peace, tolerance, justice, compassion, fairness, human rights and democracy.

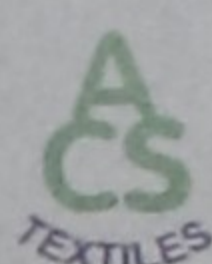
