Alauddin was the other batsman to have reached the three-figure mark as Rangpur crushed Natore by 156 runs at the Rajshahi Divisional Stadium. Opting to bat first, Rangpur amassed 253-9 with Alauddin hitting an unbeaten 117 off 84 balls. Later, Ashraful took four wickets as Natore were bowled out for 97 in 30.2 overs.






