"The administration of the club has decided that at the end of this season Frank Rijkaard will cease to be the coach of Barcelona and the position will be occupied by Josep

Guardiola," Laporta said. "He (Rijkaard) has had success but unfortunately in the last two seasons the luck has not been with

The 37-year-old Guardiola is a former Barca captain making over 250 appearances for the club between 1990 and 2001 winning six league titles and the 1992

Champions League in the process. His managerial experience is limited but the club regard him highly and resisted the temptation to go for a more experienced coach like former Chelsea manager Jose

Mourinho. "Guardiola has the knowledge, the ambition and the selfconfidence to be successful," Laporta said.

Rijkaard, a world-class player with Ajax and AC Milan, joins Mourinho in looking for a job this summer after five seasons at Camp

Rijkaard arrived at Barca in 2003 when the club was in a transitional period - after managerial spells with Sparta Rotterdam and the Dutch national team. After a difficult start the

titles in 2005 and 2006 when they also won the Champions League with a 2-1 win over Arsenal. But last season things started to go awry and Barca gifted the title to Real and their misery continued
