Seven policemen, including the then Sadar Police Station Officerin-Charge (OC), were injured during the clash with the cadres of the banned Islamist outfit. The JMB cadres also looted three shotguns, 40 bullets and a wireless set from the police.

Sixty-one JMB members were chargesheeted in this connection.

The court on May 13 took the charge sheet into cognizance and issued warrant for arrest of 10 absconding accused in the case, including Dudu Mia.


