#### BCCI kept out of World Cup ceremony

The 25th anniversary celebrations of India's 1983 World Cup-winning campaign will not involve the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) in any capacity.

It is reported that the BCCI was reluctant to get involved because a few members of that squad, including the captain Kapil Dev, have shifted to the rival Indian Cricket league (ICL), which the board has refused to recognise.

The private celebrations have been organised by Professional Management Group, a firm run by Sunil Gavaskar, who was also a member of the squad.

Speaking to the Indian Express, Kapil said it was highly unlikely the BCCI would even be invited.

"I'm not hurt that the board is not organising the function," Kapil told the paper. "Why should I be hurt? The important thing is not whether the board is backing off because of me or the ICL, but whether we will invite the board members or not. Right now, it doesn't look like that we'll interested in calling them. This is an event by Sunny [Gavaskar] and I'm helping him with it."


