### Govt opens up import of iron steel, scrap

The government yesterday allowed the import of iron steel and scrap for all to keep the skyrocketing price of MS rod at a tolerable level.

A statutory regulatory order (SRO) has already been circulated to execute the decision, a statement said yesterday.

It said the order will come into immediate effect to break the monopoly in import of scrap vessels by ship breakers.

From now on, any company which is not the member of the Ship Breakers Association (SBA) will also be able to import scrap vessels without the permission of the association, the commerce ministry statement said.

Before the circulation of this SRO it was a mandatory to be a member of the SBA for importing scrap vessels.

The government has started disbursing money among the poor farmers to enhance the production of jute and to meet the growing demand for this natural fiber in the manufacturing of jute geo-textile.

He said the demand for jute Jute geo-textiles are tex- would increase manifold when the Water Development Board would use the jute geo-textile for constructing barrage to prevent river erosion, in addition to road construction.

According to him, both public and private jute mill owners will not be able to meet the sudden growing demand of jute geo-textile when the usage of this item will be started fully, due to stock crisis. Moreover, it will not be com-

mercially viable for the country to meet the demand though imports. "As a result, the government started plans to increase the production of jute through massive cultivation," he explained. He assured that he would

write to the engineers under his ministries to use jute geotextile instead of synthetic geotextile to revive the country's lost glory of the jute sector.

He said the government has resumed processing of jute in 7 state-owned jute mills through leasing as 35,000 people are directly employed in those jute factories.
