

Food prices have doubled in three years, according to the World Bank, sparking riots in Egypt and Haiti and in many African nations. Brazil, Vietnam, India and Egypt have all imposed food export

Rising use of biofuels, trade Japanese Prime Minister Yasuo ment, gathered for the three-day restrictions, increased demand from Asia to serve changing diets, poor harvests and increasing transport costs have all been blamed for the price rise.

Lightning kills 4 of a family

Four members of a family were killed and three others injured when lightning struck their home in Chittagong's Fatikchhari upazila yesterday.

The dead were identified as Bazlu Mian, 70, of Bagan Bazar union under Bhujpur Police Station of the upazila, his son Abdul Matin, 25, grandson Jahangir Mian, 10, and granddaughter Jahanara, 6.

The injured were Bazlu's wife Razu Bibi, 55, daughter Maya, 22, and another grandson Mir Hossain, 18.

Sources said lightning hit the family's mud hut during driving rain at around 11:00am, killing the four on the spot.

Locals rushed the injured to Khagrachhari.
