Turnover at the Dhaka Stock Exchange (DSE) yesterday hit an all-time high at Tk 498.52 crore, evidence of a gradual heating up of the stock market in the country.

US stocks tumble

US stocks lost ground Tuesday after earlier gains as renewed jitters about the banking and finance sector hit investor sentiment, traders said.

Stocks fell as US media reports suggested the investment bank Lehman Brothers may seek to raise fresh capital to shore up its balance sheet.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average lost 100.97 points (0.81 percent) to close at 12,402.85 and the Nasdaq slumped 11.05 points (0.44 percent) to 2,480.48.

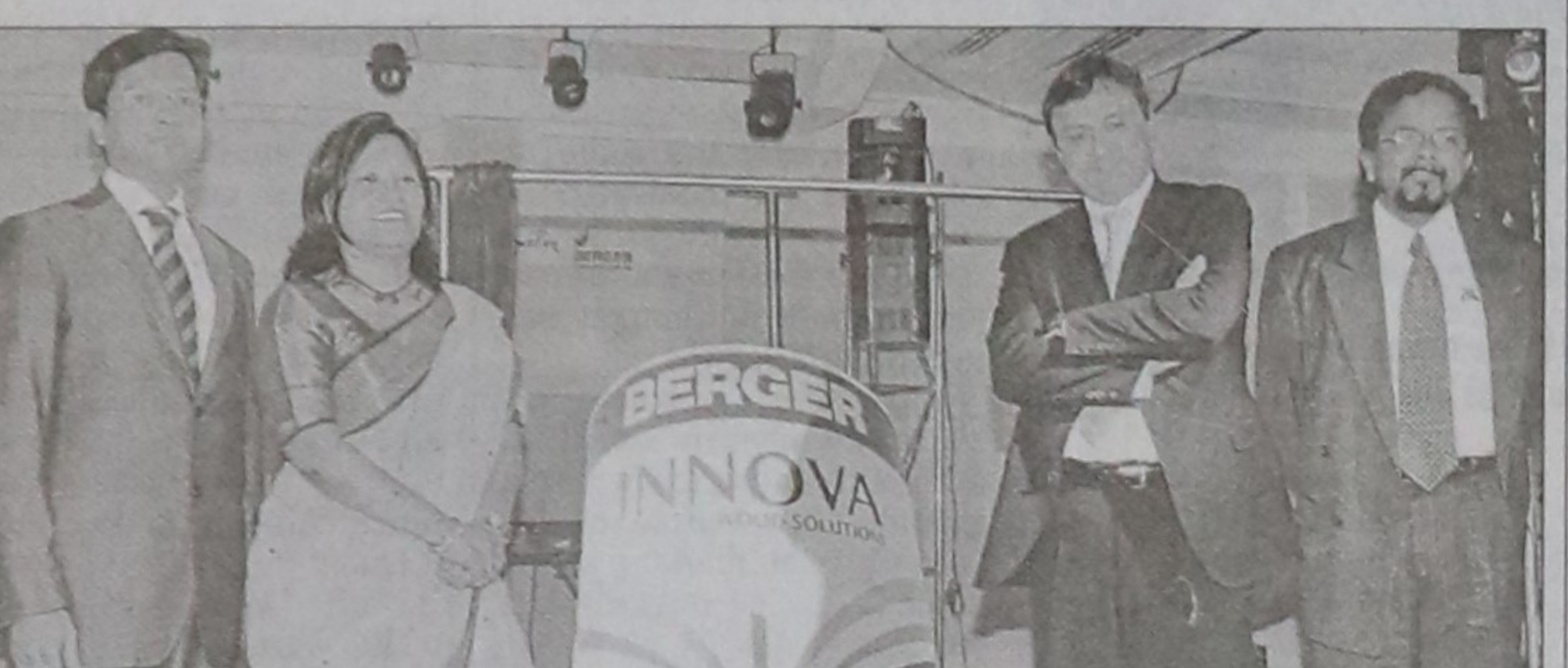
The broad-market Standard & Poor's 500 index shed 8.02 points (0.58 percent) to finish at 1,377.65.
