

CHINA KHATUN MURDER IN SATKHIRA

Ex-Jamaat MP charge-sheeted for trying to save killers

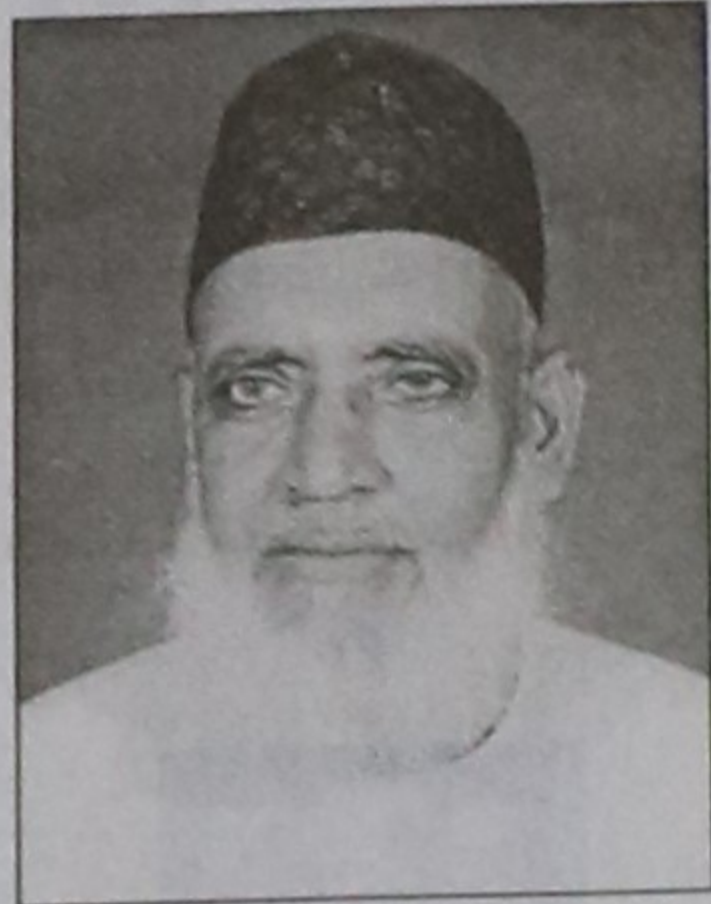

Investigation authorities have submitted charge sheet against five people including former Jamaat lawmaker Maulana Abdul Khaleque Mondal in sensational China Khatun murder case.

Khaleque Mondal has been charge-sheeted for provoking the complainant to file the sensational murder case with Sadar Police Station accusing Nazrul Islam concealing the actual motives and accused to save the culprits.

Investigation Officer (IO) of the case, assistant Superintendent of Police (ASP) Sukharanjan Samaddar of the Criminal Investigation Department (CID) submitted the charge sheet against the five people before Women and Children Repression Prevention Court at Satkhira on Monday.

The other accused in the case are -- victim China Khatun's husband Azad Hossain, her father-in-law Abdul Aziz, brother-in-law Rafiqul Islam and neighbour Nazrul Islam of village Machkhola in Sadar upazila.

China Khatun, 18, daughter of Ahmad Ali of village Nagarghata in Tala upazila was married with Azad Hossain, son of Abdul Aziz of Machkhola village in Sadar upazila, in 2001, court sources said.

Local people found the body of China, in Sadar upazila lying on the floor of her house on February 16 night in 2002. She had been pregnant for four months at that time.

The next day, China's father Ahmad Ali filed an allegation with

Sadar Police Station stating that his daughter was killed and police arrested the victim's father-in-law Abdul Aziz.

But after ten days of the incident, the victim's mother-in-law Mariam Begum submitted an allegation with the same police station against Nazrul Islam.

She also submitted a recommendation from former Jamaat lawmaker Khaleque Mondal who asked the Sadar Police Station authorities to take action against the culprit.

The complainant alleged that Nazrul entered into her daughter-in-law's room and killed her after rape on February 16 night.

As per written recommendation of former Jamaat lawmaker, the then officer in charge of Sadar Police Station Ruhul Islam Malik filed a murder case accusing Nazrul Islam, son of the victim's husband's sister, under Women and Children Repression Prevention Act.

Sub-inspector Golam Mostafa was made investigation officer (IO) and he submitted charge sheet against Nazrul Islam.

Judge Motazidur Rahman of the District Women and Children Repression Preventive Court, who tried the case, on July 30 last year ordered reinvestigation into the case as the court found that former Jamaat lawmaker Khaleque Mondal mishandled the case to divert its merit.

The physicians who conducted the post-mortem reported that they did not find any signs of rape, the court orders said.

"It is clear to the court that complainant Mariam Begum filed the case as per suggestions by the former Jamaat lawmaker. The former lawmaker, complainant Mariam Begum, the victim's father-in-law Abdul Aziz and husband Azad tried to conceal the facts in a pre-planned way," it added.

"It is necessary to take legal action against those who tried to divert the case merit concealing actual motive and accused in the case," it said, adding, "The victim's parents claimed before the court that China Khatun was killed by her husband, father in law and mother in law."

Constable held for snatching

A police constable was arrested here yesterday on charge of snatching, police said.

Arrestee Anwar Hossain (Constable No. 2879), was a messenger at Dampara police line, they said.

Anwar along with two others on board a motorbike intercepted a unidentified person in front of Mahal Complex near Laldighi area at around 2:15pm and snatched a bag full of money from him.

Hearing the hue and cry of the victim, locals came to his rescue and chased the snatchers. At one stage, they managed to catch Anwar. But others fled the scene with the money.

Later, Anwar was handed over to police.

However, Kotwali police station officer-in-charge (OC) Nurul Alam said none came to the police station with specific charges against the constable.

They might release him if none lodges case against him, the OC said.

Trader held with bombs, gun in Khulna

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) Monday night arrested a trader and recovered a gun and two bombs from his bedroom at Alka village in Phultala upazila.

The arrestee is Abul Kalam of the village.

An FIR was lodged against Kalam with Phultala police station yesterday for keeping arms and bombs.

Rab also recovered 11 bombs at Arhonghata in Daulatpur area in the city Monday night.

The bombs contained in a sack. It was found lying at the courtyard of the house of a former Union Parishad (UP) member named Akbar Ali, Rab said.

2200 urea bags seized, 5 held

Bangladesh Coastguard seized a trawler carrying 2,200 sacks of urea fertiliser from Dakatia River near Chandpur riverport yesterday afternoon.

Acting on a tip off, the law enforcers seized the fertiliser worth Tk 320 a sack as it was being smuggled to Myanmar with the help of false chalan, cash memo etc, said police and coastguard sources.

The coastguard arrested five staff of the trawler and handed them over to Sadar Model Police Station.

The arrestees are -- Mainuddin Bepari, 65, of Odiddha Sreeramdi in Chandpur Sadar, Ismail Hossain, 26, of South Tumchar in Ramgati in Laxmipur, Liton, 16, of Borokazi village in Lalmoheon in Bhola, and Humayun Kabir, 35, and his brother Ripon, 16, of Char Algi under Ramgati upazila of Laxmipur.

An organised gang is allegedly engaged in smuggling fertiliser through river routes to Myanmar from Chandpur.

UNO foils 9 child marriages arranged by NGO

The upazila nirbahi officer of Sharnkhola in Bagerhat district yesterday prevented early marriages of nine girls.

Receiving information that Islahul Muslimin Parishad, a non-government organisation (NGO), arranged marriages of nine minor girls of Sidr-hit Rajeshwar village, UNO Shahnewaz Taluker rushed there and found that the girls with their parents were present in the well-decorated venue of the marriage ceremony.

Marriage registrars Ashraf Ali and Sarwar Hossain, who were invited to complete formalities, ran away when police reached there.

OC Rezaul Karim of Sharnkhola Police Station said.

None of the NGO men could be contacted to know why they arranged early marriages of poor girls in the name of humanitarian work.

Drive against sale of carbide-ripened mango

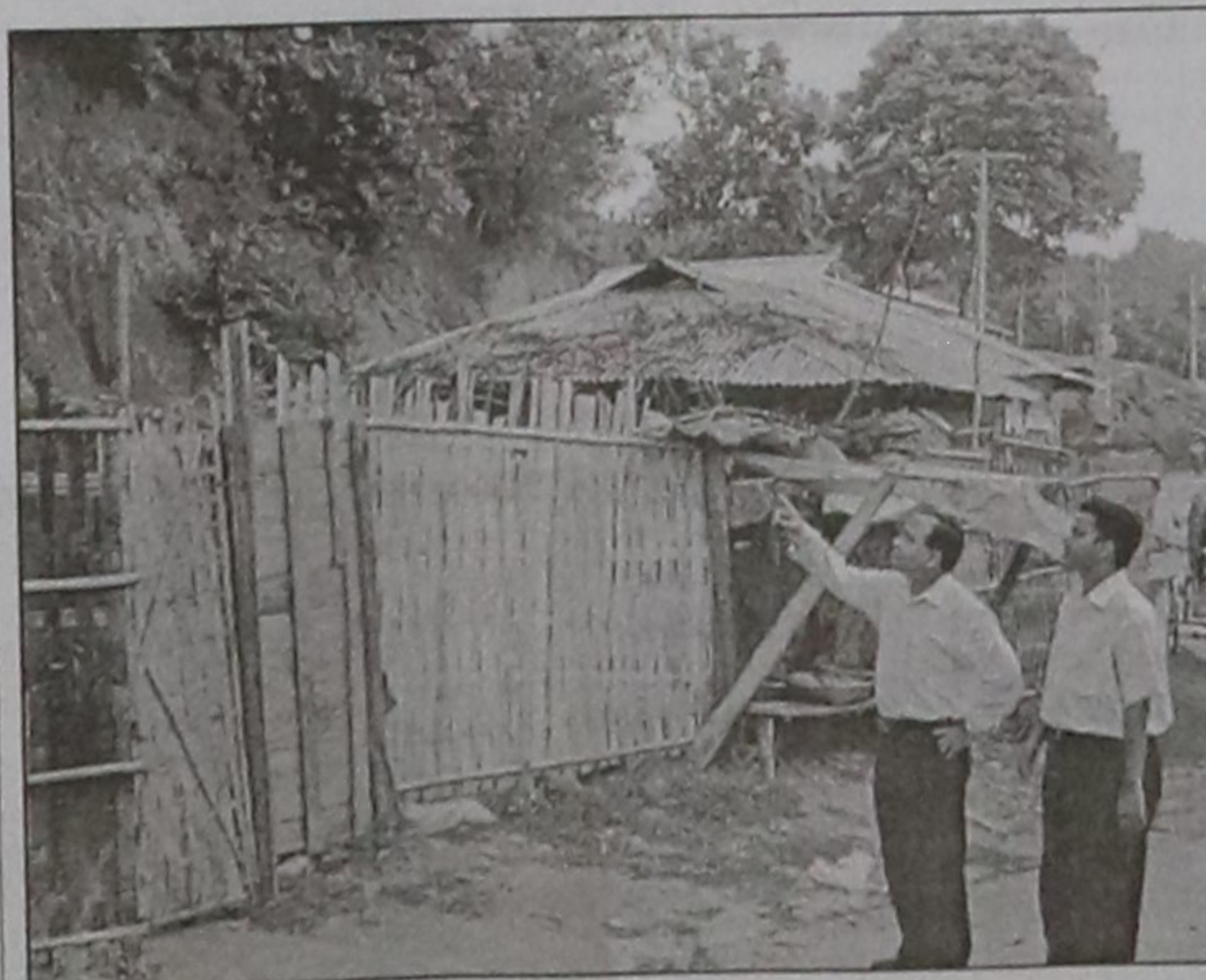

10:00am today to decide the ways of resettling those living dangerously on the hill slopes, he told the daily star correspondent after visiting the spots in the afternoon.

A seven-member team led by the deputy commissioner will discuss ways to rehabilitate the vulnerable people who have been living cutting hill illegally, he said.

12 Rajakars sued for killing two Khulna freedom fighters

Wife of a slain Freedom Fighter (FFs) on Monday lodged an FIR with Morrelganj police station accusing 12 Rajakars for killing her husband and another freedom fighter during liberation war of Bangladesh in 1971.

Amirunnesa, wife of freedom fighter Sekandar Ali Bepari lodged the FIR accusing Akram Khan alias Akam, son of late Moktar Ali Khan of Teligati village in Morrelganj upazila as the prime accused. Other accused were unnamed.

In the complaint, Amirunnesa said Akram was a gang leader of rajakars in 1971. Akram and his men had gunned down her husband Sekandar Ali and another freedom fighter Wahab Ali in front of Fakirbari at Teligati village on November 25, 1971, she said.

The two freedom fighters were killed when they were trying to go to India by boat for joining the liberation war, the

complainant said.

Morrelganj police station officer-in-charge (OC) Shajahan Khan recorded the FIR under sections 302 and 334 of Bangladesh penal code (BPC).

Sub-Inspector (SI) Rafiqul Islam became investigation officer (IO) of the case.

On contact, Morrelganj OC said Amirunnesa had submitted a petition with the court of chief judicial magistrate of Bagerhat Noor Ali seeking justice on May 2.

The chief judicial magistrate ordered Morrelganj police for an investigation, he said. After investigation, police could not find prime accused Akram at his village.

He had escaped soon after filing of the petition, the OC said.

Being confirmed about his complicity in the murder, police recorded the case, he said.

Filing of the case against the Rajakars has become a hotly discussed matter in the area.

'TORTURE' OF MAID Case recorded against Sylhet magistrate's wife

Sylhet Kotwali police yesterday recorded the case against the wife of Sylhet chief judicial magistrate for alleged physical torture on a minor housemaid.

A 3-member team from the Ain O Shalish Kendra (ASK), Dhaka reached Sylhet Monday and visited housemaid Ratna, now under treatment at MAG Osmani Medical College Hospital since Thursday night.

The victim narrated to the ASK team how she was allegedly tortured, her family members said.

The ASK team went to Kotwali police station Monday night to file a case against the judicial magistrate's wife, but police declined. However, they recorded the case yesterday.

Ratna along with her elder sister went to the police station Thursday evening and complained that she was often physically tortured by the magistrate's wife Wahida Akhtar Shanta. She also showed police some marks of torture, her family told this correspondent.

An official at Kotwali police station said they sent her to Osmani Medical College Hospital at about 8-30 pm Thursday but did not record any case.

Wahida Akhtar declined to talk about the matter over telephone.
