

Chhobir Haat: A platform for young artists

'Chhobir Haat', across the street from Institute of Fine Arts (IFA), Dhaka University, is an open-air gallery. In 2003, a group of IFA students started exhibiting and selling their artworks at the venue. The area is also widely known as 'Mollah' -- after a tea-stall owned by someone called Mollah. Chhobir Haat is akin to a rural haat, where traders in makeshift stalls or under the open sky offer their goods. The venue is open to all on Fridays -- from morning till eve-

"We often come here and discuss, share views with one another. Not just artists but also journalists, musicians, theatre activists and others related to the cultural scene often come and join our adda. The concept of Chhobir Haat emerged from these addas," said Shadhin, an IFA student, who initiated the haat along with fellow students Tuhin, Saleh and others.

Initially Tk 10-20 was levied as a toll from each artist. Now the sum has been reduced to Tk5.

Since its inception, the haat has made some achievements. According to Shadhin, "It takes an upcoming artist nearly three to four years to have an exhibition at a reputed gallery in the city. Moreover, organisers are not very helpful when it comes to promoting

upcoming artists. In this context, students can use the Chhobir Haat as a platform to showcase their latest works."

There have been several improvements over the years. For example, the muddy, unpaved ground has been upgraded to a neat concrete pavement; the venue also has electricity supply now.

The annual kite festival, organised over the last four years in Saint Martin's island, is another successful outcome. "The kite festival is a good source of recreation for all. Every kite is an artwork," added Shadhin.

Though open to all, the haat occasionally had to turn down artists from institutions other than

Armed robbers steal Picasso prints in Brazil

Three armed robbers stole two Pablo Picasso prints from a Sao Paulo art museum on Thursday in a rapid strike in which the thieves bypassed more valuable works to grab the stolen pieces, police said.

The bandits also took two oil paintings by well-known Brazilian artists Emiliano Di Cavalcanti and Lasar Segall, said Carla Regina, a spokeswoman for the Pinacoteca do Estado museum. It was the Brazilian city's second highprofile art theft in less than a year.

The Picasso prints stolen were "The Painter and the Model" from 1963 and "Minotaur, Drinker and Women" from 1933, according to a statement from the Sao Paulo Secretary of State for Culture, which oversees the museum.

The prints and paintings have a combined value of 1 million Brazilian reals (\$612,000), the statement and a museum official said.

About noon, three armed men paid the 4 Brazilian real entrance fee (\$2.45) and immediately went to the second-floor gallery where the works were being exhibited,

bypassing more valuable pieces, authorities said.

"This indicates to us that they probably received an order" to take those specific works, Youssef Abou Chain, head of Sao Paulo's organised crime unit, told reporters at a news conference

The assailants overpowered three unarmed museum guards and grabbed the works, officials said. The robbery took just 10 minutes and the museum was nearly empty at the time.

The assailants took the pieces frames and all -- out of the museum in two bags. The institution has no metal detectors.

Last December, Picasso's "Portrait of Suzanne Bloch" and "O Lavrador de Cafe" by Candido Portinari, an influential Brazilian artist, were stolen from the Sao Paulo Museum of Art by three men who used a crowbar and car jack to force open one of the museum's steel doors.

The framed paintings were found January 8, covered in plastic and leaning against a wall in a house on the outskirts of Sao Paulo, South America's largest city.

A national award finally comes Soumitra's way

He has been in cinema for half a century. He has been master director Satyajit Ray's favourite hero in his films. But it was for the first time that the 73-year-old thespian won the Indian National Award for best actor. Yes, we are talking about veteran Bengali film actor Soumitra Chatterjee. 

"Debi", "Mahanagar", "Ghare Baire" and "Sakha Prosakha".

None would have grudged Chatterjee getting the National Award for best actor much earlier. However, better late than never, even though it. is rather unfortunate consider an actor of his calibre.

There was a tinge of discontent when Chatterjee reacted to the announcement made on June 10, saying that, "it has finally come to me after such a long time." However, he said he is accepting the award "because I love my audience"

The National Film Awards for 2006, announced by Chairman of the jury and eminent director Buddhadeb Dasgputa, saw two more Bengali film personalities Goutam Ghosh and Konkona Sen Sharma bagging the awards for best cinematographer and best supporting actress.

Ghosh, essentially a director, received his award as a cameraman for "Yatra". Konkona, who had won the National Award for best actress a few years back, got the 2006 recognition for her role in the Bollywood flick "Omkara" directed by Vishal Bhardwaj.
