India warns Kashmir violence may rise

India's defence minister said yesterday he feared an upsurge of rebel attacks in disputed Kashmir in the run-up to state elections.

The warning came days after militants killed five people, including four soldiers, and hurt 15 civilians in three separate attacks.

There have also been several clashes in recent weeks along the Line of Control separating Indian and Pakistani-controlled Kashmir.

AK Antony, on a two-day visit to the region, made a thinly veiled reference to Pakistan saying there were forces "in and outside the country that did not want peaceful, free and fair elections" in Kashmir.

"These forces could try to disrupt peace and create problems. We have to be more vigilant," the defence minister said in a state-

State elections are due to be held before November 15. During the last elections in 2002, some 850 people, mostly pro-India political workers, were killed during campaigning.

The minister said Indian troops were "ready to meet any eventuality," including renewed "attempts of infiltration" by militants from across the highly militarised border with nuclear-armed rival Pakistan.

None of the soldiers' identities was released but their families had been informed.

Italian police yesterday arrested 33 Sri Lankan Tamils charged with belonging to the outlawed Tamil Tigers group fighting a separatist insurgency against the government in Colombo, an official said.
