

"Dhaka Amar Dhaka": Aiming at a brighter future

Rabiul Hossain, poet and architect, speaking at the programme "Dhaka Amar Dhaka", held on June 17 at Bengal Gallery Café, said, "Dhaka as a capital city was established in 1610, to protect Bengal from the invading Portuguese pirates." He said that our different traditional melas could be celebrated with more fervour in the following two years as Dhaka turns 400 years old. He added that our problems should be pointed out to the city's policy makers.

Sagor Lohani said, "Dhaka definitely needs to be improved. We should take pride in it as people have done while celebrating 300 years of Kolkata. Local poets and artists have been drawn to help in this project." "The celebrations," Lohani said, "will begin in July this year with a carnival that will begin from Bahadur Shah Park and end at the Parliament building premises. This will include palanquins, horse-drawn carriages and traditional costumes. There will also be elephants, bajra (large boats) and a railway engine model."

Lohani said the project hoped to print books on poems, paintings, photographs and other aspects of lifestyle pertaining to Dhaka. They also plan to have painting, fashion and photographic exhibitions along with a book fair and food festival. The Asiatic Society will be helping in this context. The plan also includes planting of saplings and cleaning of the neighbourhood.

Kamal Lohani added that intellectu s like Professor Kabir Chowdhury, Rabit L. Hossian and Muntasir Malnun were treip tomake the project a success.

Professor Kabir Chowdhury said, "For two vears we will have functions keeping the past, present and future of Dhaka in mind. We hope to involve school and university students in various activities. We plan to have programmes like film festivals, carnivals, food fairs etc."

Speaking to The Daily Star on the occasion, artist Hashem Khan said, "Dhaka is not the city one expected it to grow into. Many cities have developed around a river as

Special effects pioneer Stan Winston passes away

Oscar-winning special effects expert Stan Winston, who created the creatures in films including "Aliens" and "Jurassic Park", has died at the age of 62.

Winston, who also made the robots in "Terminator", died at home in California surrounded by family last Sunday.

The film veteran had been battling multiple myeloma, a plasma cell cancer, for seven years, a representative of the Stan Winston Studio said.

He had worked with Steven Spielberg, James Cameron and Tim Burton.

During his 40-year career, he became a pioneer of merging real-world effects with computer imaging.

California governor and former "Terminator" star Arnold Schwarzenegger said: "The entertainment industry has lost a genius, and I lost one of my best friends."

"Stan's work and four Oscars speak for themselves and will live on forever.

"What will live forever in my heart is the way that Stan loved everyone and treated each of his friends like they were family." Winston won Oscars for his

work on "Aliens", "Terminator 2: Judgment Day" and "Jurassic Park". He also received Oscar nomi-

nations for "Batman Returns", "Edward Scissorhands", "The Lost World: Jurassic Park", "A.I.", tions. "Predator" and "Heartbeeps".

Winston had recently worked on director Jon Favreau's box office success "Iron Man", starring Robert Downey Jr and the futuristic. "Avatar", for Gwyneth Paltrow.

Favreau said: "He was experidirector James Cameron.




