Chhayanat celebrates poet Sufia Kamal's birth anniversary

 On the 97th birth anniversary of Poet Sufia Kamal (1911-1999), leading cultural organisation Chhayanat arranged a musical programme at the Ramesh Chandra Dutta Smriti Milankendra, Chhayanat Sanskriti Bhavan on June 20. Chhayanat artists rendered Sufia Kamal's favourite songs, including Rabindra and Nazrul Sangeet, on the occasion.
 "When Sufia Kamal was alive, members of Chhayanat used to get together at her residence to celebrate her birthday informally with songs. Today, she is not with us but Chhayanat's gift remains the same," said Mafidul Haque, one of the trustees of

Liberation War Museum. At the programme, Mafidul Haque gave a brief speech on Poet Sufia Kamal.
 The musical soiree started with a rendition of the Nazrul Sangeet, *Jaha kichhu momo*, performed by Khairul Anam Shakil. Shakil also rendered *Keu bholey na keu bholey* and *Dolonchapanoboney*.
 Flora Ahmed Sukla rendered Rabindra Sangeet, *Pagla hawar badol din-e*. Next to perform was Sharmin Shathi Islam. The Nazrul artiste rendered *Aamaye rakhte jodi apon ghoray* and *Shanjher pakhira phirilo kulaye*.
 Laisa Ahmed Lisa rendered Rabindra Sangeet -- *Tumi ekla ghoray boshey* and *Aaj nobin megher shur legechhey*.

Human rights activist and Sufia Kamal's daughter, Sultana Kamal, reminisced on her mother at the programme. Mahmuda Akhter read out excerpts from Sufia Kamal's autobiography *Ekaley Amader Kaal*.
 Iffat Ara Dewan was the last singer to perform. She rendered *Aaji jhorer raatey* and *Aamarey tumi ashesh korechho*.
 Poet Sufia Kamal was born in Shayestabad, Barisal, to a distinguished zamindar family. During her childhood, public education for women was prohibited. She learnt Bangla, English, Urdu, Hindi, Arabic, Kurdish and Farsi from her house tutors.
 Poet Sufia Kamal was the founder president of Chhayanat.

Children Theatre Festival ends

The fortnight Children Theatre Festival organised by Peoples Theatre Association (PTA) ended on June 20 at the Shawkat Osman Auditorium, Central Public Library. Over six thousand enthusiastic child actors from all across the country participated in the festival. Over one hundred members of PTA staged plays. The organisers claimed it as the biggest festival of its kind in the country.

Besides Bengali children, ethnic minority and underprivileged child actors performed at the festival. Moreover, two troupes from India staged plays. Through dramatic presentations the child actors addressed different social issues such as discrimination and child rights. A few plays emphasised on ethics

and morality. Many plays featured pure entertainment for children. Besides children, the parents attended the festival as well. In this sense the festival had an impact on the society as a whole, as the parents also realised the necessity for better care of their offspring. To encourage the child actors the leading actors and singers of the country also attended the performances.

A youth camp, an ethnic minority camp and a seminar were also included. Moreover, enthusiastic children performed dance recitals at the festival. Eminent educationist Mustafa Nurul Islam was the chief guest at the closing ceremony. Theatre personalities Aaur Rahman, S.M. Mohsin and Jhuna Chowdhury were special guests at the programme. The discussion was presided over by Liaquat Ali

Lucky, secretary general of PTA. The main attraction of the closing ceremony was the prize distribution. A total of 102 child actors were given the "Manchakunri" award. "Manchakunri" award went to Gulnar Ferdous Sultana and "Manchoshena" award went to Yasmin Ali. Pradip Newazi received best playwright award for children's plays and Deepankar Dipan received the best director award. Best organiser award and best organisation awards went to Tariqzaman Tarique and Bandhumahal Shilpi Shangstha, Gazipur respectively. For his contribution to children's education, artist Hashem Khan received the prestigious Children Theatre Award.

PTA has organised the festival in association with Swedish SIDA, Swedish ITI, Art Venture and ActionAid.
