

RMG workers protest delay in salary payment

Several hundred workers of a garment factory in the city's Rampura area staged a demonstration blocking the busy DIT Road to protest the delay in payment of their salary and misbehaviour of factory officials.

Witnesses said the agitated workers of Megastar Apparels took to the streets at around 8:30am. They staged a demonstration and blocked the DIT Road for around

one hour. Commuters had to suffer a lot as hundreds of vehicles got stranded on the road.

Khilgaon police said the workers first staged a demonstration inside the factory and later they came out to the road.

The workers demanded the factory authorities pay their salary within seven days of the month, they added.

The police further said that the authorities later agreed to meet the demand of the workers.

Six bus robbers arrested in city

No qualitative change in democracy after 1/11

Political leaders tell roundtable

Political leaders and senior journalists at a roundtable yesterday said there has been no qualitative change in democracy after the 1/11 changeover.

They said the present situation could never be described as better than the situation during the previous political governments.

Dhaka Union of Journalists (DUJ) organised the roundtable titled 'The role of media in estab-

lishing sustainable democracy' at the Jatiya Press Club.

"It's being said that there have been positive changes in the country's socio-economic and political sectors. But where are those positive changes? We cannot feel good just saying that the post-1/11 situation is good," said BNP Joint Secretary General Nazrul Islam Khan.

It is true that politicians are partly responsible for the present political stalemate, but these politicians can give Bangladesh a sustainable democracy, he said.

He also laid emphasis on the role of media in attaining sustainable democracy.

Awami League leader Advocate

Abdul Hamid blamed the politicians for massive corruption in the country.

He asked the politicians to change their characters and exchange views and opinions among themselves so that the country does not face another 1/11.

Former adviser Sultana Kamal urged the politicians and the people of all walks of life to work together to save the country from the political instability.

Chief Editor of Bangladesh Sangbad Sangstha (BSS) Jaglul Ahmed Chowdhury, Editor of the Bhorer Kagoj Shaymol Dutt and Prof Dr AAMS Arefin Siddique of Dhaka University also spoke.

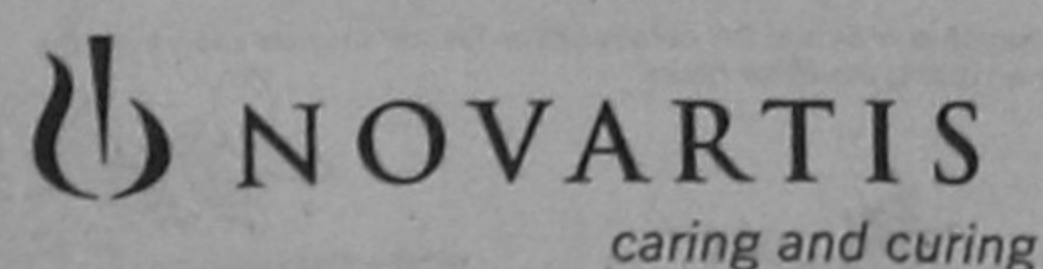
