

Skeleton of a man killed two years ago was exhumed yesterday for DNA test and probe into the alleged murder. Police exhumed the skeleton of

from the rail track at Shimultala in the upazila on March 29, 2006. On the following day, Marjul, Khejur Ali and Abdus Sattar, member of Chatian Union Parishad (UP), filed a general diary with Mirpur police station terming it a suicide by

'mentally retarded' Sona Mondol. Two days later, Chalak Ali, sonin-law of Sona Mondol, filed a murder case against five persons. They were Marjul, UP member Abdus Sattar his son Milon Ali, Abul Hossain and Asia Khatun.

In his case, Chalak claimed that

Marjul and his men killed Sona as

he came to know an extra marital

Khatun. Asia was wife of Kader Joarder of the village. Sona's family sources earlier claimed that Marjul and Milon called

him (Sona) out of his house on the

Police had also submitted
