#### Community pry teachers call off hunger strike

Community primary teachers yesterday decided to postpone their indefinite hunger strike following a request from Primary and Mass Education Adviser Rasheda K Choudhury.

The Bangladesh Community Primary Teachers Association (BCPTA) planned to stage indefinite hunger strike at the Central Shaheed Minar in the capital from August 3 to press for their fivepoint demand, including nationalisation of their job.

In a joint statement, BCPTA President Habibul Ahsan Bablu and Secretary General Hafizur Rahman said Adviser Rasheda requested them to postpone the strike.

"She assured us that our demands will be met after the chief adviser and the finance adviser return home after attending the 15th Saarc Summit," the statement

BCPTA Secretary General Hafizur Rahman, however, said they would stage the hunger strike from August 25 if their demands are not met by August 24.




