Energy & Mineral Resources Division has been allocated with Grant from the Royal Norwegian Government being administered by the Asian Development Bank (ADB) under the project titled "Gas Transmission and Development Project (GTDP) (Loan No. 2188/2189-BAN(SF))" towards the cost of the "Strengthening of the Hydrocarbon Unit in the Energy and Mineral Resources Division (Phase -II)", and intends to apply part of the proceeds of these funds to payments under the contract for the provision of Consultancy Services by a Consulting Firm for "Petroleum Resource Management".

Energy and Mineral Resources Division the Executing Agency (EA; hereinafter referred to as the 'Employer') now invites Expression of Interests (EOI) from internationally reputed eligible consulting firms, or joint ventures of consulting firms, from ADB's member countries, and listed in ADB's Database of Consulting Firms (CMS), for short listing for the Consultancy Services. Consultancy will be required for a period of 20 (twenty) months, intermittently, during April 2009 to September 2011, comprising of the experts for the following services:

a) Project Co-ordination (International) as Team Leader	(7 Person-Month)
b) Reservoir Engineering (International)	(5 Person-Month)
c) Data Management (International)	(5 Person-Month)

The Terms of Reference (TOR) of the consultant will include following among others:

i) Activity Planning and Promotion of Exploration

Establish and improve management systems and procedures for the evaluation of policy options with regard to activity planning and promotion of exploration. The policy considerations will be based on technical evaluation input from Petrobangla complemented by analytical work in HCU. This activity shall suggest the functions and input required from Petrobangla and IOCs regarding resource assessment, prospect evaluation, resource inventory systems and supervision of exploration and production activities.

ii) Planning of Field Development and Depletion

Establish and improve management systems and procedures for the evaluation of policy Options with regard to field development planning, area planning and reservoir management. This activity shall address requirements for technical assessment activities including enhanced recovery techniques.

iii) Optimal Gas Utilization

Review available similar type of reports on Gas Utilization and develop policy considerations and policy options with regard to the utilization of natural gas in Bangladesh. The focus of this study should include strategies for regulation of gas infrastructure, facilitation of local use, development of a regional market, etc. and also comparing different options for gas use, particularly as regards socio-economic impacts.

iv) Resource Classification System, Reporting Regime and Database Model

Review the resource classification system for Bangladesh. To describe how the resource situation changes over time, the petroleum resources have to be classified into various classes depending on profitability and maturity. The system shall describe the in-place and recoverable resources, discovered and undiscovered, produced and remaining, in a consistent manner. Establish procedures for data reporting in co-operation with the operating companies and Petrobangla. Build a database model for the resource assessment.

v) Petroleum Resource Assessment.

Perform a comprehensive assessment of the country's petroleum resources. For the discovered resources the operator's assessment will form the basis. However, independent studies may be conducted for selected discoveries and fields. Undiscovered resources will be estimated based on mapped prospects and leads, and on basin modeling analysis.

vi) Updating the Resource Inventory

Establish routines for updating the resources inventory based on new information and/or new independent studies. An official resource assessment update shall be done on an annual basis.

vii) Establish Data Management System

Establish an archive system and guidelines for data reporting from the operators in order to ensure a consistent reporting of data, and in order to minimize the efforts in incorporating the data in the national archive system.

The main elements of the activity will be:

- To define an archive system for storage and retrieval.
- To define standard format and storage medium for digital data.
- Implement guidelines for reporting new data.
- Reformat existing databases and incorporate the data in the archive system.

- The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of the Gas Transmission & Development Project (PART-B) and it is intended that part of the proceeds of this loan will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for procurement of 3-D seismic equipment and materials.
- Bangladesh Gas Fields Company Limited (BGFC), a company of Bangladesh Oil, Gas & Mineral Corporation (Petrobangla) now invites sealed bids from the eligible bidders from member countries of the ADB for supply and delivery of Explosive, Detonator, Cone & Anchor Set for appraisal of five gas fields (Titas and Bakhrabad Gas Fields under BGFC and Sylhet, Kailashitla & Rashidpur Gas Fields under Sylhet Gas Fields Limited) to upgrade the estimated gas in place and also to determine the exact location for future drilling activities.
- Supply and services under the contracts shall be within 120 (one hundred twenty) days counting from 21 days after issuance of commitment letter by ADB.
- International competitive bidding will be conducted in accordance with ADB's Single-Stage: One Envelope bidding procedure and is open to all bidders from eligible source countries (detail procedures are provided in the bidding document).
- The bidding document will be available from 10.08.2008 to 30.09.2008 between 0900 hrs and 1400 hrs BST on all working days (Sunday to Thursday) from BGFC Liaison Office at House No. 75, Road No. 6, Old DOHS, Banani, Dhaka-1213, Bangladesh on payment of Taka 5,000.00 (non-refundable). Alternately, the bid document can be obtained through express mail service on receipt of payment of USD 150.00 (non-refundable) in STD Account No. 22, Sonali Bank, Brahmanbaria Branch, Brahmanbaria, Bangladesh. No liability will be accepted for loss or late delivery. No tender document will be sold on the tender opening day.
- Bid must be accompanied with a bid security in an amount of BTK. 20,00,000.00 or equivalent foreign currency in the form of bank guarantee/irrevocable letter of credit/cashier or certified cheque from any reputable bank from an eligible countries. In case of bank guarantee issued by a foreign bank, the bank guarantee must be endorsed by a registered scheduled bank in Bangladesh or a scheduled foreign bank operating in Bangladesh. - The foreign currency cost will be met out of Asian Development Bank (ADB) Loan No. 2188-BAN, received by GOB towards financing of the Gas Transmission and Development Project, Part-B. The local currency cost will be financed by GOB through its Annual Development Programme.
- Scope of supply, terms of supply, information required to be furnished by the bidder, mode & submission procedures of bids etc are detailed in the bid document.
- Only reputed & experienced manufacturer/suppliers from ADB member countries are eligible to participate in the bidding. Materials will also be mined/produced in ADB member countries.
- Bids must remain valid for 120 days from the date of closing of the tender.
- Bidders shall bear all costs associated with preparation and submission of their bids and BGFC will, in no case, be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.
- Bids will be received at the Liaison Office of BGFC at address above up to 1100 hrs (BST) on 01.10.2008 and will be opened on the same day at 1130 hrs (BST) in presence of the bidder(s) representative, if any. Late bids shall be rejected. If the bid cannot be received and opened due to the unavoidable circumstances or holiday on scheduled date and time, bid shall be opened at the same venue and time on the subsequent working day.
- In the comparison of bids ADB's Domestic Preference Scheme will be applied in accordance with the provision stipulated in the instruction to bidders.
