# Pricy fertilisers make Aman prospect bleak in Rangpur

Farmers say they cannot afford a TSP bag at Tk 3800

The yield of Aman paddy in Rangpur district is likely to be 30 to 35 percent less than targetted five lakh 50 thousand tonne of paddy as most of the farmers failed to use Triple Super Phosphate (TSP) and Murate of Potash (MoP) in time.

There was not adequate supply of TSP and MoP in July when most of the ropa aman lands are cultivated and about 60 per cent of ropa aman fields in the district was cultivated without TSP and MoP, said farmers and sources at Agriculture Extension Aman in July, the new allotment Department.

Besides, price of the fertilisers have almost doubled and it seems to frustrate use of fertiliser in the remaining fields of Aman paddy in the district.
