


To celebrate ten years of practicing and promoting Rabindra Sangeet, Cultural organisation Rabirashmi has arranged a three-daylong programme featuring music and poetry at Central Public Library, Shahbagh.

The cultural fest began on August 28 at Shawkat Osman Memorial Auditorium, Central Public Library. Founded in 1998, Rabirashmi has been working towards popularising Rabindra Sangeet. The slogan of this year's festival is "Gaaney gaaney bondhon jaak tutey."

Veteran Tagore artiste and exponent Kalim Sharafi inaugurated the festival. This year's festival has been dedicated to the memory of recently deceased playwright-actor and director Abdullah Al Mamun. Seasoned artiste Subir Nandi has won the National Film Award for "best playback singer (male)" for the year 2004. The song, Bhalobashi shokaley, is from the film Megher Porey Megh (directed by Chashi Nazrul Islam and produced by Impress Telefilm Ltd). Emon Shaha is the music composer and Gazi Mazharul Anwar is the lyricist of the song.

National Film Awards for the last four years were announced recently.

About the award-winning song, Subir Nandi says, "Gazi bhai's songs are always of a certain standard, so I agreed to sing it right away. Emon Shaha's treatment of the song was rather unusual considering the ongoing trend in film music. He had a minimalist approach to the use of musical instruments. The composition has the feel of film songs from yesteryears."

Prior to this, Subir won National film awards in 1984 for the song Amar e duti chokh (from Alamgir Kabir's film Mahanayak), in 1986 for a comprehensive performance in Chashi Nazrul Islam's film Shubhoda (lyrics by Mohammad Rafiquzzaman and music direction by Khandokar Nurul Alam) and in 2002 for the song Ekta chhilo sonar konya (from Humayun Ahmed's film Srabon Megher Din; music direction by Maqsud Jamil Mintu).

Subir's reaction to the award: "Any kind of recognition or appreciation encourages an artiste. A nod from the state is the highest honour for a performer. All the films and songs that & have received awards this time give us hope that better days are ahead for our filmdom. And every award-winning accomplishment is teamwork." Among others summer





Madonna has always revelled in controversy and with the recent launch of her concert tour, "Sticky & Sweet," the 50-year-old pop star has kicked up a new fuss by comparing John McCain to Adolf Hitler in a video.

The dust-up is the latest in a career of risky moves that have paid off handsomely for Madonna, whose tours and albums have long mixed music with politics, sex and religion. While other stars rose to fame in the 1980s then faded away, "Material Girl" Madonna has become a global star and even courted controversy to stay rele-

vant to younger audiences. "Madonna seems to be a brilliant business woman in the culture scene," said Robert Thompson, a professor of media and pop culture at Syracuse University. "She's controlled her contro- John McCain


Abraham Foxman, national issued a statement calling it "out-McCain's campaign blasted rageous to invoke Nazi imagery in the context of John McCain's candidacy."

Madonna had previously drawn the ire of the Vatican. Her 1989 song "Like A Prayer," with links between religion and eroticism, caused Pepsi-Cola to cancel a sponsorship deal.

While Thompson noted that Madonna has successfully boosted her career in the past with controversy, he added that celebrities should speak their minds if they want.

But David Horowitz, a conservative writer and activist, took a more dim view of Madonna's latest controversy.

"We're in a sad situation if we're turning to entertainers for political wisdom," he told Reuters.
