





# Apurbo's Eid plans

With his bedroom eyes and pensive looks, Apurbo has won the hearts of many TV viewers. One of the busiest actors now, Apurbo looks forward to Eid. Indeed, it's only during the Eid vacation when he gets to relax and unwind with family and friends. The model-turned actor talked to *The Daily Star* recently about his Eid plans.

Talking about Eid-special TV plays, Apurbo says, "I've worked in five plays directed by Ferdous Hassan: *Lokhi Tera*, *Apod Bidaye*, *Aj Robibar*, *Madhumita* and *Sa Re Ga Ma Pa*. Most of the plays are comedies. However, I play diverse characters. In *Apod Bidaye*, I play a rural character with a passion for Bangla films. In *Sa Re Ga Ma Pa*, my character is speech impaired. In the more serious *Madhumita*, I play the character of a *ghar jama* (a man who stays with his in-laws). I enjoyed working in all of them.

"There are two plays directed by Chayanaika Chowdhury, titled *Hypocrite* and *Meytir Chokhey Chheleir Bhalobasha*. My role in the former was quite challenging. Directed by Arif Khan and written by Badrul Anam Soud, the play *Chander Aloye Koyekjon Jubok* is another notable play this Eid. It is an adaptation of a Humayun Ahmed novel. All the plays will be aired on different TV channels on the occasion of Eid."

As Apurbo has been busy shooting for the Eid specials, he looks forward to stay home and relax during the holiday. "My Eid schedule includes going to the mosque for the Eid prayers with my brothers and father, meeting my neighbours and friends. I will also catch up with relatives whom I haven't meet in a while because of my busy schedule. Otherwise, my uncles, aunts and others might forget me," says Apurbo in a lighter vein. "Will keep the next day exclusively for my friends. Besides I will entertain the guests who come to our home," adds the actor.

About his Eid clothes, Apurba has a definite response: "Of course it will be a *panjabi*, one of my favourite attires. The colour and material will depend on the weather. If it is a hot day, I prefer white. May be in the evening I will wear something dark, something eye-catching if I go to a party. Actually I always try to go casual. I also have many gifts to choose from, especially what my mother has bought for me."

"What is most encouraging, is to see how local designers have captured the fancies of the consumers," says the busy actor.

# "Mad Men", "30 Rock" take top Emmy Awards



Tina Fey, executive producer of "30 Rock," accepted the award for outstanding comedy series. Fey also won Emmys for writing and acting.

The sleek '60s drama "Mad Men" made Emmy history Sunday as the first basic-cable show to win a top series award, while the sitcom "30 Rock" and its stars Tina Fey and Alec Baldwin also emerged as big winners.

"We're all so very grateful to have jobs in this turkey-burger economy," Fey said after accepting the best comedy series trophy for her satire about a late-night TV show.

"This is the greatest job I've ever had in my life," Baldwin said about his role of a network executive.

"I thank my parents for somehow raising me to have confidence that is disproportionate with my looks and abilities. Well done. That is what all parents should do," said Fey, who also won for best actress

and writing in a comedy series.

Emmy voters rewarded quality, not ratings: Many of the winners draw relatively small audiences. AMC's "Mad Men," which looks at America through the prism of Madison Avenue, is lucky to get 2 million viewers.

Glenn Close of FX's "Damages" and Bryan Cranston of AMC's "Breaking Bad" captured drama-acting trophies.

Close, honoured for her portrayal of a ruthless attorney, complimented her fellow nominees, including Holly Hunter and Sally Field.

"We're proving that complicated, powerful, mature women are sexy in high entertainment and can carry a show," she said. "I call us the sisterhood of the TV drama

divas."

Cranston won the trophy for his role of a desperate man who turns to making drugs.

Dianne Wiest of "In Treatment" and Zeljko Ivanek of "Damages" won supporting acting honors for the drama series. Jean Smart of ABC's "Samantha Who?" was honoured as best supporting actress in a comedy series, with Jeremy Piven her actor counterpart for "Entourage."

"I really look forward to the next administration, whoever it is," Jon Stewart said as he accepted the best variety, music or comedy series award for "The Daily Show." "I have nothing to follow that. I just really look forward to the next administration. Tommy Smothers received a commemorative writing achievement for his work

on the cutting-edge and controversial "The Smothers Brothers Comedy Hour" from the late '60s--and turned serious.

"It's hard for me to stay silent when I keep hearing that peace is only attainable through war. And there's nothing more scary than watching ignorance in action," he said, dedicating his award to "all people who feel compelled to speak out, and are not afraid to speak to power, and won't shut up and refuse to be silenced."

The award for best TV movie went to "Recount," about the contested 2000 Bush-Gore contest.

HBO's "John Adams," about the founding father of USA, was named best miniseries and won other awards including acting trophies for Paul Giamatti, Laura Linney and Tom Wilkinson.

The historical drama set a record for most awards, 13, including five trophies Sunday and eight previously announced. The record of 11 was held by HBO's "Angels in America," the TV academy said.

HBO was the most-honoured network, with 26 awards earned Sunday and at the creative arts ceremony held earlier this month. ABC was second with 12 awards, followed by CBS, NBC and PBS with 10 each; AMC with eight, Showtime with five and Fox with four.

Throughout the evening, the ceremony kept its landmark 60th birthday in the spotlight with salutes to television's past.

Pop star Josh Groban offered a marathon medley of TV theme songs, ranging from "The Simpsons" to "Mister Rogers' Neighborhood" to "South Park" to "Gilligan's Island." At one point, Ed McMahon kicked in a "Heeere's Johnny!" to salute Johnny Carson's "Tonight" show.
