

Eid in mind, stocks spike

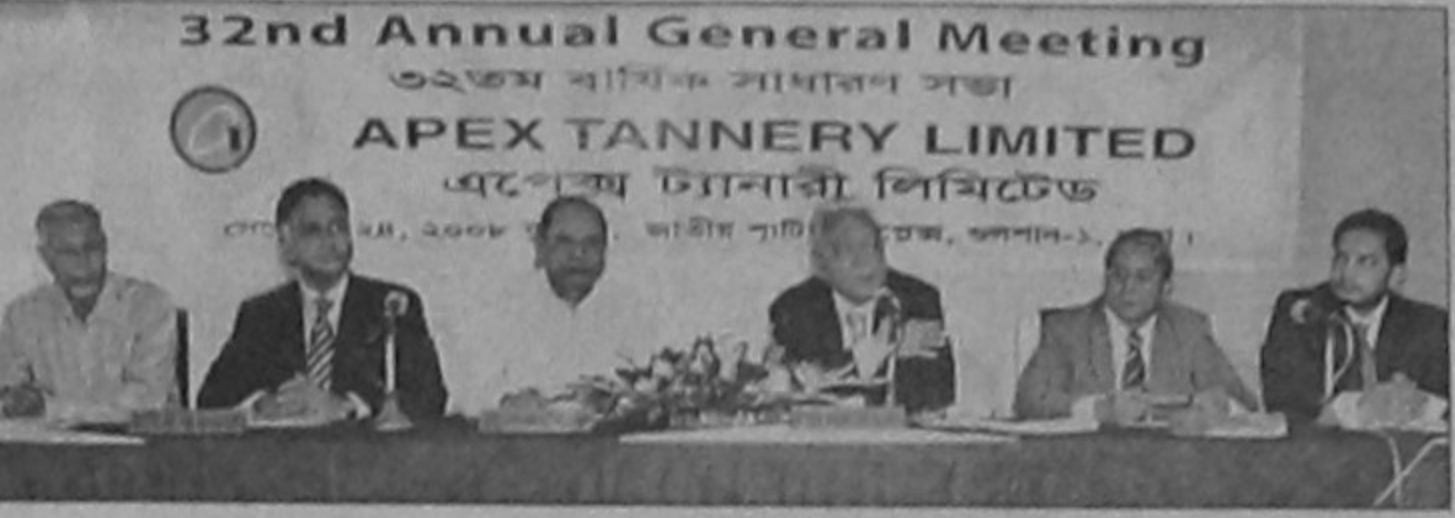

The benchmark index of Dhaka Stock Exchange, DSE General Index, rose 41.36 points, or 1.41 percent, to 2966.81 points.
